## **SKILL LEVEL - BEGINNER**

### **Before you begin -**

Shira originally designed and knit this amazing blanket as a way to relax and stash bust.

Consider this pattern as a general guide for making a crochet version – if you don't have every color, or start to run out of a color, use yarn from your stash. This will truly make the blanket your own!

### **SIZE**

About 35 x 44 in. (89 x 112 cm)

### **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® FIFTY FIFTY (ART. #479)
  - #101 Pink 4 balls (A)
- LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® THICK & QUICK® (Art. #640)
  - #178 Cilantro 2 skeins (B)
  - #099 Fisherman 1 skein (C)
  - #127 Peanut 2 skeins (D)
- LION BRAND® GO FOR FAUX™ (Art. #322)
  - #211 Blonde Elk 2 balls (E)
  - #203 Pomeranian 2 balls (F)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size P-15 (10 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

### **GAUGE**

7 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with A.

BUT DON'T WORRY TOO MUCH ABOUT YOUR GAUGE, WE WANT THIS BLANKET TO BE A JOY TO MAKE!

### **NOTES**

1. Shira's Shi Blanket is made with multiple yarns to create stripes.
2. We did our best estimating yarn amounts! If you find that you're running low on a yarn, just end your stripe a bit sooner.
3. To begin a new stripe, change yarn color in last st of last row of old color. To change yarn color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Leaving a long beginning tail, yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on

hook to complete stitch. Cut old yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. You'll weave in the yarn tails when you finish the Blanket.

## **BLANKET**

With A, ch 62.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc) and in each ch across – you will have 60 dc in this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, skip first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch.

With A, rep Row 2 for about 8 in. (20.5 cm).

With E, rep Row 2 for about 5 in. (12.5 cm).

With B, rep Row 2 for about 3 in. (7.5 cm).

With C, rep Row 2 for about 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm).

With D, rep Row 2 for about 2 in. (5 cm).

With B, rep Row 2 for about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm)

With F, rep Row 2 for about 5 in. (12.5 cm).

With A, rep Row 2 for about 7 in. (18 cm) or until there isn't enough yarn remaining to complete another row.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

Cuddle up under your new blanket!

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)
