#### **PREPARATION**

Wash your hands and nails well, making sure to remove any dirt under your nails using soap, a nail brush, and warm water.

Trim your nails with a finger-nail cutter if they are too long, and file them gently using the nail file supplied to remove any sharp edges. Only file the tip of the nail, not the top surface, as filing the surface will weaken the nail


After filing your nails, always wash and thoroughly dry your hands to make sure that nail dust cannot spoil your nail polish.

#### PAINTING YOUR NAILS - BASE COAT

Always shake the nail polish before use to ensure that the colours are evenly mixed. For best results you should paint your nails with smooth, continuous


strokes of the brush, starting at the base of the nail (the cuticle) and painting towards the tip of the nail in a single stroke, using the brush supplied inside the lid of each nail polish. After dipping the brush in the nail polish, wipe the brush on the inside of the bottle neck to remove the excess paint and form the bristles of the brush into a good shape.

You should be able to paint smaller nails in two strokes of the brush, as shown:





Larger nails will need three strokes of the brush:



It is better to apply several thin coats of nail polish, rather than one thick coat, because this will produce a more even application. Most colours will only need two coats, but light colours, such as white, may need three coats. Allow each coat to dry before applying the next coat - if you apply the next coat too soon, the nail polish may lack gloss, or become streaky.

If you make a mistake, wait for the nail

polish to dry, peel it off the nail or wash it off the skin with soap and warm water), or dry the nail and start again.

## TOP TIP:

Lighter colours work best as base colours as applying a light colour on top of a dark colour may make it appear less vivid!





#### OMBRE NAIL ART

To achieve the best ombre effect start with a white base coat, this will help the colours to stand out more when being applied on top. Make sure that this is completely dry before placing the nail masks onto your fingers.

#### USING THE NAIL MASKS

There are three different sizes of masks: the large one for your thumb, the medium ones for your index, middle and ring finger and the small one for your little finger.

The masks are soft, so they'll mould to the shape of your finger; the aim is to position the mask snugly around your nail to prevent any varnish from getting onto the skin surrounding your nail.



#### POSITIONING THE MASKS

To correctly position the masks, pull each one down your finger with the opening facing upwards, the crosspiece should sit just under your nail.





### APPLYING THE NAIL COLOUR

Choose two contrasting nail varnish colours, for example, bright pink and orange. Using opposing colours will make the ombre effect more striking. Holding the sponge steady, paint about 0.5 cm wide stripe of the first lighter colour in a sweeping motion, moving in one direction.



Make sure you apply a generous amount as the sponge can absorb a lot of the varnish. Repeat this process again with your second colour, overlapping the stripes slightly to blend the colours.






#### CREATING THE BLEND

Once both colours have been applied orientate the stripes horizontally and gently dab the sponge down on to your masked nail. Keep dabbing lightly and move slightly up and down your nail to ensure the colours blend in the middle. Make sure not to wipe the sponge away whilst still in contact with your nail.





#### FINISHING THE OMBRE DESIGN

Repeat for all of your nails and finish with a transparent topcoat which will prevent your designs from chipping or scratching.

Once your nails are dry, wash your nail masks and sponges with warm water and soap to reuse again and again!



#### NAIL ART

Make sure that the base coat of nail polish is completely dry before painting designs onto it.

Use the small paint brush to paint the designs onto your nails. Apply a tiny amount of paint to the brush, wipe the brush on the inside of the bottle neck to remove the excess paint and form the bristles of the brush into a good shape, then hold the brush vertically (as shown) and lower it gently onto the nail to begin painting.

It requires patience to get this exactly right, so you may need to try a couple of times before you get it right!









## TOP TIPS:

- Do not overload the brush.
- Paint using only the tip of the brush. Keep the brush vertical at all times.



Where possible, it is best to paint paler colours onto the nail first, so to paint a pink heart design onto a black background, it is best to paint the nail pink first, then paint the black outline of the heart shape onto the nail, then paint black around the heart shape.

#### REMOVING THE NAIL POLISH

Once the nail varnish is dry, it can be peeled off your nail in a single sheet. Any excess that is stuck to the skin can be removed using soap and warm water.

#### UNICORN AND STARS STICKERS

Peel the sticker from the backing sheet by folding the sheet, and apply carefully to the nail. Once your design is complete, paint with transparent varnish as described.

#### DESIGN YOUR OWN

Here (right) are some designs that we like, shown step by step. You can use these as inspiration and then go on to design your own.

# TOP TIP:

To paint a dot, it is best to paint in a very small circle on the nail.


