SKILL LEVEL - BEGINNER

SIZE

About 30 x 59 in. (76 x 150 cm)

MATERIALS

LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® THICK & QUICK® (Art. #640)

#127 Peanut 2 skeins (A) #99 Fisherman 7 skeins (B)

LION BRAND® GO FOR FAUX™ (Art. #322)

#200 Mink 1 ball (C)

• LION BRAND® LB COLLECTION® FIFTY FIFTY (Art. #479)

#149 Charcoal 1 ball (D)

#101 Pink 4 balls (E)

- LION BRAND® crochet hook size P-15 (10 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

7 hdc = about 5 in. (12.5 cm) with A. DON'T WORRY TOO MUCH ABOUT YOUR GAUGE! GAUGE WILL VARY BETWEEN THE YARNS.

NOTES

- 1. Blanket is worked in one piece. The center section is worked in rows, so you'll turn the piece for each row. The border is worked in the round without turning.
- 2. This Blanket is meant to be fun and improvisational an expression of your own creativity! Use different yarn colors and to change color as you like to make it your own!
- 3. To begin a new yarn color, change yarn color in last st of old color. To change yarn color, work last stitch of old color to last yarn over. Leaving a long beginning tail, yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the stitch. Cut old yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. You'll weave in the yarn tails when you finish the Blanket.

BLANKET

With A, ch 33.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (the 2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 32 hdc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, skip first st, hdc in each st across, working last hdc in top of beginning ch.

Continue to repeat Row 2, changing yarn color following Diagram, until you've completed the stripes shown on Diagram.

Your Blanket should measure about 51 1/2 in. (131 cm) from beginning. Fasten off.

Border

Note: The border is worked all around outside edge of Blanket – in rounds instead of rows.

Join any color yarn with a slip st anywhere along outside edge of Blanket.

Round 1: Ch 2, work hdc evenly spaced around outside edge of Blanket, working 3 hdc in each corner. When you reach the beginning ch, join the last st you worked with a slip st in the top of the beginning ch.

Round 2: Ch 2, work hdc in each hdc around, working 3 hdc in the center st at each corner; join the last st you worked with a slip st in the top of the beginning ch.

Continue to repeat Round 2, changing yarn color as you like. Shi's border measured about 3 3/4 in. (9.5 cm) wide, but you can keep going to use up all of your yarn.

At the end of the last round, fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
hdc = half double crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)
