

Free Knitting Pattern LION BRAND® A STAR IS BORN: OH BABY BABY OMBRE THROW

Pattern Number: M20104 OB



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

SIZES

About 33 x 36 (84 x 91.5 cm))

MATERIALS

LION BRAND® A STAR IS BORN: OH BABY (Art. #173)

#098 Ecru 3 balls (A)

#140 Rose 4 balls (B)

#141 Mauve 3 balls (C)

LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long

GAUGE

21 sts = about 5 1/2 in. (14 cm) over St st (k on RS, p on WS) with 2 strands of yarn held tog.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Throw is worked with 2 strands of yarn held tog throughout.
- 2. Yarn color is changed to form stripes. When changing yarn color, change one strand at a time.
- 3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.

THROW

With 2 strands of A held tog, cast on 126 sts.

With 2 strands of A held tog, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 7 1/4 in. (18.5 cm) from beg.

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, work in St st for about 7 1/4 in. (18.5 cm).

With 2 strands of B held tog, work in St st for about 7 1/4 in. (18.5 cm).

With 1 strand each of B and C held tog, work in St st for about 7 1/4 in. (18.5 cm).

With 2 strands of C held tog, work in St st for about 7 1/4 in. (18.5 cm).

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

p = purl

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

tog = together

WS = wrong side
