**LION BRAND® A STAR IS BORN: OH BABY  
GRANNY BABY THROW**

Pattern Number: M20103 OH



## SKILL LEVEL – Easy

## SIZES

About 34 x 34 (86.5 x 86.5 cm)

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® A STAR IS BORN: OH BABY (Art. #173)
  - #103 Coral 3 balls (A)
  - #110 Navy 3 balls (B)
  - #109 Denim 3 balls (C)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size F-5 (3.75 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## GAUGE

Rnds 1-6 = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm).

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

## NOTES

1. Throw is worked in joined rnds for the center outwards.
2. Yarn color is changed every other rnd. To change yarn color, fasten off old color and join new color, as instructed.

## THROW

With A, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in ring, (ch 1, 3 dc in ring) 3 times, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-1 sps in this rnd (Four 3-dc groups).

**Rnd 2:** With A, sl st in next 2 dc, sl st in first ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same ch-1 sp (corner made), (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in each of next 3 ch-1 sps; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 24 dc and 4 corner ch-1 sps (Two 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps).

*Fasten off.*

**Rnd 3:** From RS, join B with a sl st in any corner ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups; rep from \* 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 36 dc and 4 corner ch-1 sps (Three 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps).

**Rnd 4:** With B, sl st in next 2 dc, sl st in first ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same corner ch-1 sp, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, (3 dc in next sp between 3-dc groups) twice; rep from \* 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 48 dc and 4 corner ch-1 sps (Four 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps).

*Fasten off.*

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**Rnd 5:** From RS, join C with a sl st in any corner ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to next corner, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to next corner; rep from \* 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 60 dc and 4 corner ch-1 sps (Five 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps).

**Rnd 6:** With C, sl st in next 2 dc, sl st in first ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), (2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in same corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to next corner, \*(3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, 3 dc in each sp between 3-dc groups to next corner; rep from \* 2 more times; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 72 dc and 4 corner ch-1 sps (Six 3-dc groups along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps).

*Fasten off.*

Rep Rnds 5 and 6, changing yarn color every 2 rnds as follows:\* Work next 2 rnds with A, 2 rnds with B, 2 rnds with C; rep from \*, until piece measures about 34 in. (86.5 cm) square, ending with 2 rnds worked with C as the last rnds you work.

*Fasten off.*

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
