



Free Knitting Pattern

LION BRAND® COVER STORY

KINSTON AFGHAN

Pattern Number: M20122 CV



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

FINISHED SIZES

About 48 x 52 in. (122 x 132 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® COVER STORY (Art. #533)
#153 Ebony 1 cake
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 11 (8 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

5 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern Rows 1-8.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Yo (*yarn over*)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right hand needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

1. Afghan is worked in one piece in a simple stitch pattern.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the width of the piece. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.

AFGHAN

Cloosely cast on 59 sts.

Knit 7 rows.

Pattern Stitch

Row 1 (right side): Knit.

Rows 2, 4 and 6: Knit 5, purl to last 5 sts, knit 5.

Row 3: Knit 8, *yo, k2tog, knit 4; rep from * to last 9 sts, yo, k2tog, knit 7.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 7: Knit 8, *knit 3, yo, k2tog, knit 1; rep from * to last 9 sts, knit 9.

Row 8: Rep Row 2.

Repeat Rows 1-8 until piece measures about 52 in. (132 cm) from beginning end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Knit 6 rows.

Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)
