



Free Crochet Pattern

LION BRAND® 24/7 COTTON®
GRANNY SQUARE JACKET

Pattern Number: M20213 TC



SKILL LEVEL – Easy

FINISHED SIZES

S (M, L, 1X, 2X)

Finished Bust About 39 (42, 45, 48, 51) in. (99 (106.5, 114.5, 122, 129.5) cm)

Finished Length About 22 3/4 (24 1/2, 26 1/4, 28, 29 3/4) in. (58 (62, 66.5, 71, 75.5) cm), not including body trim

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow the pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® 24/7 COTTON® (ART #761)
 - #116 Succulent 5 (6, 7, 8, 9) balls (A)
 - #156 Mint 2 (2, 3, 3, 4) balls (B)
 - #158 Goldenrod 2 (2, 3, 3, 4) balls (C)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

Rnds 1-5 of Square = about 6 x 6 in. (15 x 15 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Jacket is made from 29 Squares and 6 Half Squares.
2. Squares are worked in joined rnds with RS always facing. Do not turn at beg of rnds.
3. Half Squares are worked back and forth in rows.
4. Finished Squares and Half Squares are sewn together following a diagram to make the Jacket.

SQUARES (make 29)

With B, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), (3 dc in ring, ch 1) 3 times, 2 dc in ring; join with loose sl st in beg ch-4 sp – you will have 12 dc and 4 ch-1 sps in this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), 3 dc in beg ch-4 sp (same ch-sp as joining sl st), *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-1 sp (corner made); rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, work 2 more dc in beg ch-4 sp; join with loose sl st in beg ch-4 sp – 24 dc and 8 ch-1 sps (Two 3-dc groups and 1 ch-1 sp along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps). Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS, join C with sl st in any corner ch-1 sp, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), 3 dc in same corner ch-1 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp; rep from * 2 more times, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, work 2 more dc in beg ch-4 sp; join with loose sl st in beg ch-4 sp – Three 3-dc groups and 2 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Rnd 4: From RS, join A with sl st in any corner ch-1 sp, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), 3 dc in same corner ch-1 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp; rep from * 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, work 2 more dc in beg ch-4 sp; join with loose sl st in beg ch-4 sp – Four 3-dc groups and 3 ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps.

Next 1 (2, 2, 3, 3) Rnds: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), 3 dc in beg ch-4 sp, *(ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp; rep from * 2 more times, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, work 2 more dc in beg ch-4 sp; join with loose sl st in beg ch-4 sp – 5 (6, 6, 7, 7) 3-dc groups and 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) ch-1 sps along each of 4 sides between corner ch-1 sps in last rnd.

Sizes S (L, 2X) ONLY

Next Rnd: Ch 1, sc in beg ch-4 sp, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp around; join with sl st in first sc – 19 (23, 27) sc along each of 4 sides between corner sc. Fasten off.

Sizes M (1X) ONLY

Fasten off.

HALF SQUARES (make 6)

Row 1 (WS): With B, ch 4. (dc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1, 2 dc) in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc) – you will have 7 dc and 2 ch-1 sps in this row.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-1 sp (corner made), ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-1 sp (corner made), ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 14 dc and 5 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Row 3: From WS, join C with sl st in first dc, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in beg ch-4 sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 19 dc and 6 ch-1 sps. Fasten off.

Row 4: From RS, join A with sl st in first dc, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 26 dc and 9 ch-1 sps.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in beg ch-4 sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 31 dc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Size S ONLY

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across – 41 sc (19 sc between corner sc). Fasten off.

Size M ONLY

Row 6: From RS, join A with sl st in first dc, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) twice, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 4 times, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 38 dc and 13 ch-1 sps (Six 3-dc groups and 5 ch-1 sps between corner ch-1 sps). Fasten off.

Size L ONLY

Row 6: Work same as Row 6 for size M.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across – 51 sc (23 sc between corner sc). Fasten off.

Size 1X ONLY

Row 6: Work same as Row 6 for size M.

Row 7: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) to next corner ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next corner ch-1 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, dc in beg ch-4 sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 43 dc and 14 ch-1 sps (Seven 3-dc groups and 6 ch-1 sps between corner ch-1 sps).

Fasten off.

Size 2X ONLY

Rows 6 and 7: Work same as Rows 6 and 7 for size 1X.

Row 8: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp across – 57 sc (27 sc between corner sc). Fasten off.

FINISHING

Block Squares to the following measurements:

Size S: About 6 1/2 x 6 1/2 in. (16.5 x 16.5 cm).

Size M: About 7 x 7 in. (18 x 18 cm).

Size L: About 7 1/2 x 7 1/2 in. (19 x 19 cm).

Size 1X: About 8 x 8 in. (20.5 x 20.5 cm).

Size 2X: About 8 1/2 x 8 1/2 in. (21.5 x 21.5 cm).

Block Half Squares to the same length and half the width of the Squares.

Sew Squares and Half Squares together following diagram.

Sew side and sleeve seams.

Sleeve Trim

Note: Rnd 1 of sleeve trim is worked in sts of last rnd of Squares at wrist edge. If making size S, L or 2X, in Rnd 1 when instructed to work into a ch-1 sp, work into the sc in the last rnd immediately above the ch-1 sp.

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sl st in any ch-1 sp of one sleeve edge, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp or seam between Squares; rep from * around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Rnd 2: Turn, sl st in first ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS join C with sl st in any ch-1 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, , *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * around, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3.

Fasten off.

Rep around second sleeve edge.

Body Trim

Note: If making size S, L or 2X, in Rnd 1 when instructed to work into a ch-1 sp, work into the sc in the last rnd immediately above the ch-1 sp.

Rnd 1 (RS): From RS, join B with sl st in any ch-1 sp of lower back edge, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-1 sp, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp or seam between Squares; rep from * all the way along lower edge, up front edge, around neck edge, down opposite front edge and along remaining lower edge, working (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in front lower and top corners, ch 1; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3. Notes: When working along front edges, work (ch 1, 3 dc) pattern as evenly spaced as possible. At inner corners of neck opening, work a dc in the corner ch-1 sp of all 3 of the adjoining corners.

Rnds 2 and 3: Work same as Rnds 2 and 3 of sleeve trim.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
