



Free Knitting Pattern
LION BRAND® PIMA COTTON
DIRECTIONAL SHAWL
Pattern Number: M20185 PC



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 24 x 55 in. (61 x 139.5 cm) at longest and widest

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® PIMA COTTON (Art. #762)
 - #148 Rain Cloud 1 ball (A)
 - #099 Vintage 1 ball (B)
 - #159 Mineral Yellow 1 ball (C)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long

GAUGE

17 sts + 33 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every st on every row).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then knit through back of same stitch – 1 st increased.

NOTES

- Shawl is made from 2 triangles.
- Both triangles are worked in Garter st (k every st on every row).
- Triangle I is worked first, then sts for Triangle II are picked up along one edge of Triangle I.
- The yarn color is changed to make stripes.
- A circular needle is used to accommodate the width of piece. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.

SHAWL

Triangle I

With A, cast on 2 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Row 1 (RS): Kfb, k1 – you'll have 3 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: Kfb, k to end of row – 4 sts.

Row 4: Knit.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 until you have 49 sts.

Cut A.

Begin Stripes

Note: When working with 2 yarn colors across a row, twist yarns each time you change color to prevent holes from forming.

Row 1 (RS): With B, kfb, place marker (pm); with C, k to end of row – 50 sts (2 B sts and 48 C sts).

Row 2: With C, k to marker, slip marker (sm); with B, k to end of row.

Row 3: With B, kfb, k to marker, sm; with C, k to end of row – 51 sts (3 B sts and 48 C sts).

Row 4: With C, k to marker, sm; with B, k to end of row.

Rows 5-12: Rep Rows 3 and 4 for 4 more times – 55 sts (7 B sts and 48 C sts) in Row 12.

Cut C.

Do not remove marker. Continue to slip marker as you come to it.

Row 13: With B, kfb, k to end of row – 56 sts.

Row 14: With B, knit.

Rows 15-24: Rep Rows 13 and 14 for 5 more times – 61 sts in Row 24.

Rows 25-36: Using B and C as instructed, rep Rows 3 and 4 for 6 times – 67 sts (19 B sts and 48 C sts) in Row 36.

Rep Rows 13-36 until you have 103 sts (55 B sts and 48 C sts).

Bind off using yarn color to match sts.

Triangle II

Row 1 (RS): From RS with B, pick up and k103 sts evenly spaced along straight side edge (opposite increase edge) of Triangle I.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 – 102 sts.

Row 4: Knit.

Rows 5 and 6: Rep Rows 3 and 4 – 101 sts.

Cut B.

Rep Rows 3 and 4 changing yarn color as follows: *Work next 18 rows with A, 6 rows with B; rep from * for a total of 3 A-colored stripes and 4 B-colored stripes. You will have 65 sts remaining, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

With C, rep Rows 3 and 4 until only 2 sts remain.

Last Row: With C, k2tog.

Fasten off last st.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

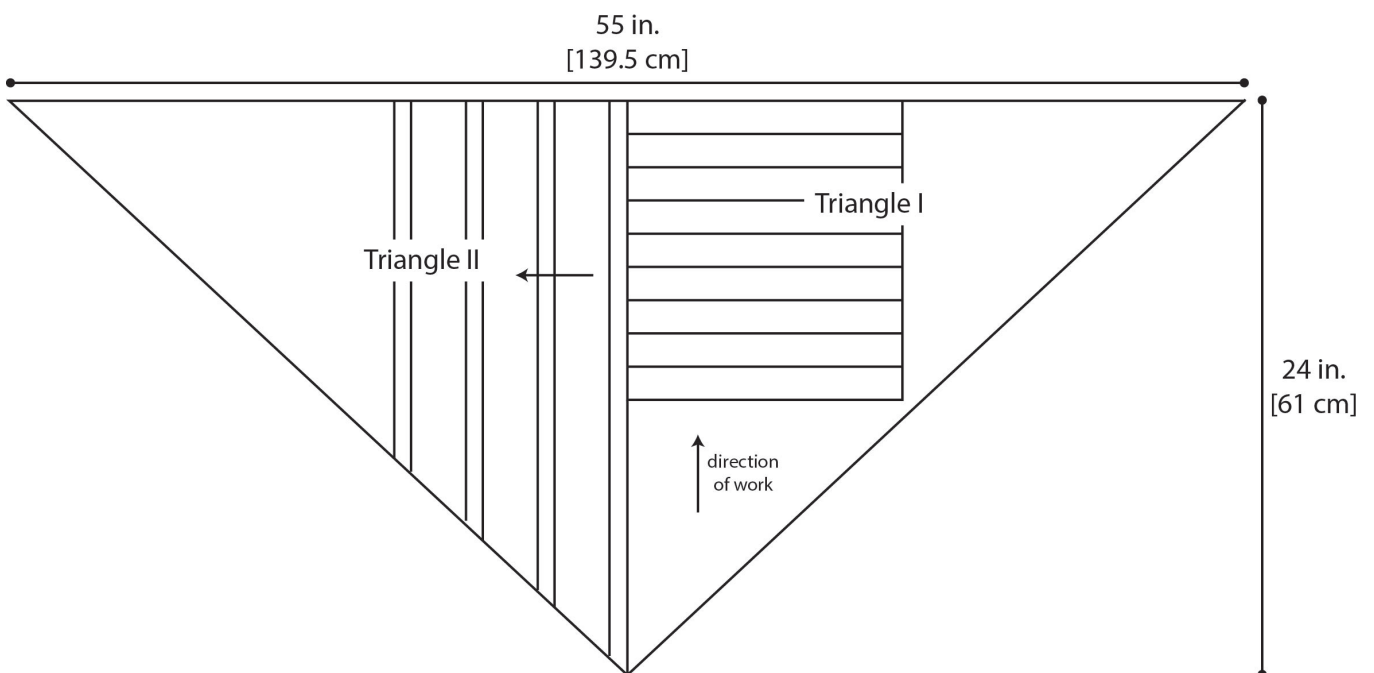
rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)
