Lion Brand® Touch of Angora

Shiloh Shawlette

Pattern Number: L90251



SKILL LEVEL - EASY

SIZE

About 20 x 28 in. (51 x 71 cm) at longest and widest

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® TOUCH OF ANGORA (Art. #681)
#098 Ecru 1 ball
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCHES

Garter Stitch Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, p1.

Row 2 (Increase Row – WS): Sl 1, k to last 2 sts, kfb, p1 – 1 st increased.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 for Garter st pattern.

Eyelet Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Sl 1, kfb, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, p1.

Note: On some repeats on Row 2 of the Eyelet pattern you may have an additional stitch remaining at the end of the pattern repeat - just knit that stitch.

Row 2 (Increase/Eyelet Row – WS): Sl 1, *yo, p2tog; rep from * to last 2 sts, kfb, p1 – 1 st increased.

Row 3: Rep Row 1.

Row 4 (Increase Row – WS): Sl 1, k to last 2 sts, kfb, p1 – 1 st increased.

Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 1-4.

NOTES

1. Shawlette is worked in one piece, in alternating sections of a Garter st pattern and an Eyelet pattern.
2. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of stitches.
3. After the first 2 rows, Shawlette is shaped by increasing at the beginning and decreasing at the end of every RS row and increasing at the end of every WS
4. Slip the first st of every row as if to purl, with yarn in front of work.

SHAWLETTE

Cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (Increase Row – RS): Sl 1, kfb, k1, p1 – you will have 5 sts in this row.

Row 2: Sl 1, k2tog, kfb, p1.

Note: When measuring, always measure along the decrease edge (along the left side edge, when RS is facing).

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Garter st pattern until piece measures about 14 in. (35.5 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Work 16 rows of Eyelet pattern.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Garter st pattern for about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Work 16 rows of Eyelet pattern.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Garter st pattern for about 4 in. (10 cm), end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Work 16 rows of Eyelet pattern.

Beg with Row 1 of pattern, work in Garter st pattern for about 1 in. (2.5 cm).

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Dampen Shawlette thoroughly. Spread a towel onto a flat surface, then lay Shawlette onto towel and smooth into shape.

Allow to air dry.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
