ALIEN COSTUME SET

SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

Child 2T

Finished Hat Circumference About 18 in. (45.5 cm)

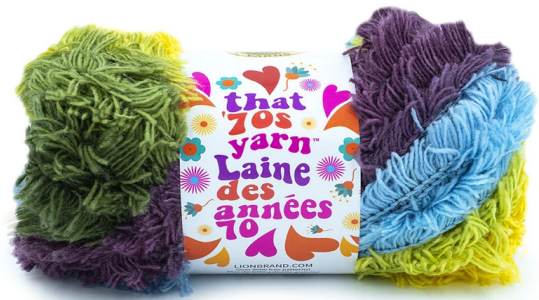
Finished Hat Height About 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm)

Finished Romper Chest About 24 in. (61 cm)

Finished Romper Length About 15 in. (38 cm)

MATERIALS

- **LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI PILLING™** (Art. #202)
#100 White 2 balls (A)
- **LION BRAND® THAT 70'S YARN** (Art. #705)
#603 Wowzer 3 balls (B)
- **LION BRAND® VANNA'S CHOICE®** (Art. #860)
#100 White 1 ball (C)
#153 Black 1 ball (D)
- **LION BRAND®** crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- **LION BRAND®** crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
- **LION BRAND®** large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

15 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with smaller hook and A.

6 dc = about 3 1/4 in. (8.5 cm) with larger hook and B.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

1. Romper is worked in one piece. Work begins at the lower front edge and continued up to shoulders. A neck opening is made and then work continues from shoulders down to lower back edge.
2. An edging is worked around armholes and lower edge.
3. Hat is worked in one piece in joined rounds from the top downwards.
4. Eyes are worked separately and sewn to Hat.

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTE

The costume should be worn only with constant adult supervision. Never leave a child unattended with the costume or wearing the costume. Don't allow a child to play with any element of the costume.

ROMPER

FRONT

With smaller hook and A, ch 47.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), and in each ch across – you will have 45 dc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st; rep from * across – 23 dc and 22 ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each ch-1 sp and dc across – 45 dc.

Rows 4-25: Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 11 more times.

Make Neck Opening

Row 26: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st) 3 times, ch 27, sk next 27 sts (for neck opening), dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st) 4 times – 2 sets of 5 dc and 4 ch-1 sps and a center ch-27.

BACK

Row 27: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, (dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) 4 times, dc in each of next 27 ch, dc in next dc, (dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc) 4 times – 45 dc.

Rows 28-51: Rep Rows 2 and 3 for 12 more times.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold front over back, matching lower and side edges. Place markers on each side of front and back about 4 3/4 in. (12 cm) from fold (shoulders). Sew side seams from lower edges to markers, leave the 4 3/4 in. (12 cm) open for armholes.

Lower Edging

Rnd 1: From RS, with larger hook, join B with sl st around post of any dc of 2nd row above lower edge. *ch 1, sl st around post of next dc in same row; rep from * around.

Rnds 2-5: Sk next row of Romper, sl st around post of dc in next row of Romper directly above last sl st worked, *ch 1, sl st around post of next dc in same row; rep from * around.

Fasten off.

Armhole Edging

From RS, with larger hook, join B with sl st in underarm; working in ends of rows around armhole edge, *ch 1, sk end of next row, sl st in end of next row; rep from * around; join with sl st in underarm.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

HAT

With larger hook and B, ch 5; sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 10 dc in ring; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 11 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), 2 dc in each st around; join with sl st in first dc – 22 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), *dc in next st, 2 dc in next st; rep from * around; join with sl st in first dc – 33 dc.

Rnds 4-6: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), dc in each st around; join with sl st in first dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, (sk next st, sc in next 4 sts) 6 times; join with sl st in first sc – 27 sc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

EYES (*make 3*)

With smaller hook and C, ch 4.

Rnd 1: Work 12 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch do not count as a st); join with sl st in first dc – 12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc – 24 sc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Pupil

With smaller hook and D, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc – 6 sc.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

FINISHING HAT

Sew a Pupil to each Eye, then sew Eyes to front of Hat.

Weave in any remaining yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

ch = chain

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)
