



Free Crochet Pattern

LION BRAND® I WANNA MAKE A BLANKIE

UNICORN BLANKET

Pattern Number: M20131 WMB



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 33 x 38 in. (84 x 96.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® I WANNA MAKE A BLANKIE (Art. #532)
 - #203 Calluna 1 cake (A)
 - #100 Snow 1 cake (B)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

1 ripple = about 8 1/4 in. (21 cm) measured from peak to peak.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

STITCH EXPLANATION

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased

NOTES

1. Blanket is worked in a ripple pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. The ripple pattern consists of alternating peaks and valleys. Peaks are formed by working 2 dc in each of 2 sts. Valleys are formed by working (dc2tog) twice. Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each row aligned.
3. Yarn color is changed every other row to form stripes.
4. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

BLANKET

With A, ch 67.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc), dc in next 5 ch, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 5 ch, *2 dc in each of next 2 ch, dc in next 5 ch, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 5 ch; rep from * to last ch, 2 dc in last ch – you will have 4 ripples in this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, dc in next 5 sts, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 5 sts, *2 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in next 5 sts, (dc2tog) twice, dc in next 5 sts; rep from * to beg ch-3, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3 and change to B in last st.

Rows 3 and 4: With B, rep Row 2 twice. Change to A in last st of Row 4.

Rows 5 and 6: With A, rep Row 2 twice. Change to B in last st of Row 6.

Rows 7-34: Rep Rows 3-6 for 7 more times.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)
