

Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® I WANNA MAKE A BLANKIE COW BLANKET

Pattern Number: M20132 WMB



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 30 x 35 in. (76 x 89 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® I WANNA MAKE A BLANKIE (Art. #532)
 #152 Iron 1 cake (A)
 #100 Snow 1 cake (B)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



11 dc = about 6 in. (15 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

NOTES

- 1. Blanket is worked in one piece in rows of double crochet (dc).
- 2. The spots are worked separately and sewn to Blanket.

BLANKET

With A, ch 57.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc) and in each ch across – you will have 55 dc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, skip first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 35 in. (89 cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

SMALL SPOTS (make 3)

With B, ch 5.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 2 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 2 ch, 3 sc in last ch; join with sl st in first sc - 11 sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, 2 dc in next st, 2 tr in next st, ch 3, sl st in next st; leave rem sts unworked.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

LARGE SPOTS (make 5)

With B, ch 5.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 4 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in first st, dc in next st; leave rem sts unworked – 2 dc.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.



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Row 5: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), do not turn, work 5 dc evenly spaced along side edge.

Row 6: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in first 3 sts; leave rem sts unworked.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Using yarn tails, sew Spots onto Blanket as desired. *Weave in ends.*

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

rem = remain(ning)

rep = repeat

rnd = round

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

tr = treble (triple) crochet
