

Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® I WANNA MAKE A BLANKIE CAT BLANKET

Pattern Number: M20133 WMB



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SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 37 x 37 in. (94 x 94 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® I WANNA MAKE A BLANKIE (Art. #532)
 #150 Pearl Grey 1 cake (A)
 #100 Snow 1 cake (B)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



5 x 5 in. (12.5 x 12.5 cm) cardboard square (for making tassels)



6 sts = about 4 in. (15 cm) in alternating (sc, dc) pattern of Row 2.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

NOTES

- 1. Blanket is worked in rows of alternating single crochet (sc) and double crochet (dc) stitches.
- 2. Yarn color is changed every other row to form stripes.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

BLANKET

With A, ch 57.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch, *sc in next ch, dc in next ch; rep from * across – you will have 56 sts in this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, dc in next sc, *sc in next dc, dc in next sc; rep from * across, change to B in last st.

Rows 3 and 4: With B, rep Row 2 twice. Change to A in last st of Row 4.

Rows 5 and 6: With A, rep Row 2 twice. Change to B in last st of Row 6.

Rep Rows 3-6 until piece measures about 37 in. (94 cm) from beg, end with 2 rows worked with A as the last rows you work.

Fasten off.



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FINISHING

Tassels (make 4)

Cut a 10 in. (25 cm) length of B, thread onto blunt needle and set aside for tie.

Wrap B around cardboard 12 times. Insert threaded needle under all strands at one edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at opposite edge of cardboard. Cut a 6 in. (15 cm) length of B and wrap tightly around loops 1 in. (2.5 cm) below top knot. Knot securely; then thread ends into needle and weave to center of tassel. Trim tassel ends evenly.

Tie a tassel to each corner of Blanket.

Weave in ends.
