



Free Crochet Pattern

LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH PREMIUM™

LACY THROW

Pattern Number: M20171 BSP



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZE

About 51 x 68 in. (129.5 x 172.5 cm), not including tassels.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH PREMIUM™ (Art. #201)
#158 Saffron 10 balls
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

12 hdc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

shell Work (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in indicated st.

NOTES

1. Throw is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
2. A border is worked around the outside edge.
3. Twisted cord tassels are attached along the short edges of completed Throw.

THROW

Ch 154.

Row 1: Working in back bumps only, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 153 hdc in this row (counting the beg ch-2 as first hdc).

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch-2.

Rows 3-6: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch-2.

Row 7: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st; rep from * across working last dc in top of beg ch – 77 dc and 76 ch-1 sps.

Row 8: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 dc, shell in next dc, *sk next dc, dc in next dc, sk next dc, shell in next dc; rep from * to last 2 dc, sk next dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 19 shells and 20 dc.

Row 9: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3), turn, sc in ch-2 sp of first shell, *ch 3, dc in next dc between shells, ch 3, sc in ch-2 sp of next shell; rep from * across, ch 3, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 19 sc, 20 dc, and 38 ch-3 sps.

Row 10: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc in first ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in next sc, *ch 1, dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in next sc; rep from * to beg ch-6 sp, ch 1, dc in beg ch-6 sp, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-6 – 77 dc and 76 ch-1 sps.

Row 11: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each dc and ch-1 sp to beg ch-4 sp, 2 dc in beg ch-4 sp – 153 dc.

Rows 12-15: Rep Rows 7-10.

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Row 16: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each dc and ch-1 sp to beg ch-4 sp, 2 hdc in beg ch-4 sp – 153 hdc.

Rows 17-21: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch-2. Rep Rows 7-21 until piece measures about 68 in. (172.5 cm) from beg, ending with a Row 21 as the last row you work.

Do not fasten off.

Border

Round 1: Ch 1, turn, sc evenly spaced all the way around outer edge of Throw, working 3 sc in each corner; join with slip st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Tassels

1. For each tassel, cut three 18 in. (45.5 cm) strands of yarn.
2. Beginning at one corner of a short side of the Throw, pull all 3 strands halfway through the first edge stitch.
3. With 3 strands in right hand and 3 strands in left hand, twist both sets of strands separately clockwise until they are tightly twisted. Keeping both sets of strands taut, bring both sets of strands together and allow them to twist around each other counter clockwise.
4. Tie an overhand knot at your desired tassel length. Trim strands to create an even tassel end.
5. Add tassels all the way along both short sides of Throw, skipping every other st.

Weave in ends.
