

Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® DOUBLE CROCHET SCARF

Pattern Number: L90321 WE



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SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 6 1/2 x 74 in. (16.5 x 188 cm), not including fringe

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND[®] WOOL-EASE[®] (Art. #620) #402 Wheat 3 skeins (A) #140 Rose Heather 1 skein (B)
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size 7 (4.5 mm)

GAUGE

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern of Rows 1-8.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

STITCH EXPLANATION

Bobble Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook), (yarn over, insert hook in same st and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 4 times, yarn over and draw through all 6 loops on hook. **Note:** In this design, the yarn color is changed to B in last yarn over of st before a Bobble and changed back to A in last yarn over of the Bobble.

NOTES

- 1. Scarf is worked back and forth in rows of a double crochet (dc) and Bobble st pattern.
- 2. Yarn color is changed before and after each Bobble st, so that all dc sts are worked with A and all Bobble sts are worked with B.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Color not in use may be "carried" underneath sts of color in use or may be fastened off and rejoined when next needed, whichever you prefer. If fastening off and rejoining, leave long tails to weave in later.

SCARF

With A, ch 28.

Foundation Row: With A, dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch do not count as a st) and in each ch across – you will have 25 dc in this row.

Row 1: Ch 3 (does not count as a st and throughout this pattern), turn, dc in first 2 sts, change to B; Bobble in next st, change back to A; dc in next 19 sts, change to B; Bobble in next st, change back to A; dc in last 2 sts – 25 sts.

Note: Continue to change to B before starting each Bobble and change back to A at the end of each Bobble.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in first 4 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in next 15 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in last 4 sts.

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Row 3: Ch 3, turn, dc in first 6 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in next 11 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in last 6 sts. Row 4: Ch 3, turn, dc in first 8 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in next 7 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in last 8 sts. Row 5: Ch 3, turn, dc in first 10 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in next 3 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in last 10 sts. Row 6: Ch 3, turn, dc in first 2 sts, Bobble in next st, (dc in next 9 sts, Bobble in next st) twice, dc in last 2 sts. Rows 7-11: Rep Rows 2-6. Rows 12-15: Rep Rows 2-5. Row 16: Ch 3, turn, dc in first 12 sts, Bobble in next st, dc in last 12 sts. Note: Rows 17-132 are worked with A only. Rows 17-132: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across. Row 133: Rep Row 16. Row 134: Rep Row 5. Row 135: Rep Row 4. Row 136: Rep Row 3. Row 137: Rep Row 2. Row 138: Rep Row 6. Rows 139-143: Rep Rows 134-138. Rows 144-147: Rep Rows 134-137. Row 148: Rep Row 1. Row 149: Ch 3, turn, dc in each st across. Fasten off.

<u>FINISHING</u>

Fringe

For each fringe, cut 4 strands of yarn, each about 10 in. (25 cm) long. Use a mix of yarns A and B as desired. Hold strands together and fold in half. With hook, draw fold through edge of Scarf, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten.

Make fringe evenly spaced across each end of Scarf, then trim fringe ends evenly.

Weave in ends. Wet block, if desired.

ch = chain dc = double crochet rep = repeat st(s) = stitch(es)
