**LION BRAND® OFF THE HOOK® GLITZ
LOOP TRIMMED PILLOW**

Pattern Number: M20235 OHG



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 10 in. (25.5 cm) diameter

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® OFF THE HOOK® GLITZ (Art.#519)
 - #158 Banana 2 balls (A)
 - #184 Peach 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Round pillow form 10 in. (25.5 cm) diameter

A few yards (meters) of smooth yarn

FRONT

With A, join 6 loops to make a ring as follows: pull the first loop through the 6th loop.

You'll now be working around the ring – working in rounds.

Round 1: Pull up 2 loops in each loop around the ring – you'll have 12 loops around the ring.

Round 2: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in next loop; repeat from * around – you'll have 18 loops.

Round 3: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 2 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 24 loops.

Round 4: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 3 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 30 loops.

Round 5: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 4 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 36 loops.

Round 6: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 5 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 42 loops.

Round 7: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 6 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 48 loops.

Round 8: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 7 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 54 loops.

Now you'll need to finish off your loops. Drop the working yarn.

Working in the same direction as the last round you made, pull the second loop through the first; pull the third loop through the second; pull the fourth through the third – and so on across to the end of the round.

Now you're back at the working yarn. Cut the working yarn, leaving a yarn tail with about 4-5 loops. Carefully snip these remaining loops off the working yarn tail. Pull working yarn through the last loop and knot.

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BACK

Make same as Front.

Finish your Pillow

Thread the blunt needle with a length of smooth yarn and sew the Front and Back together, leaving about half of the Pillow unsewn. Insert the pillow form through the unsewn opening, then finish sewing closed.

With your fingers, stuff any visible yarn tails to the inside of the Pillow.

Edging

Pull up 2 loops of B in each loop around the outside edge of the Pillow. With blunt needle and matching smooth yarn, sew around the loops to keep them in place.
