**LION BRAND® OFF THE HOOK® GLITZ
STRIPED CIRCLE RUG**

Pattern Number: M20236 OHG



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 37 in. (94 cm) diameter

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® OFF THE HOOK® GLITZ (Art.#519)
 - #158 Banana 3 balls (A)
 - #184 Peach 2 ball (B)



RUG

With A, join 7 loops to make a ring as follows: pull the first loop through the 7th loop.

You'll now be working around the ring – working in rounds.

Round 1: Pull up 2 loops in each loop around the ring – you'll have 14 loops around the ring.

Round 2: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in next loop; repeat from * around – you'll have 21 loops.

Round 3: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 2 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 28 loops.

Round 4: Change to B. *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 3 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 35 loops.

Round 5: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 4 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 42 loops.

Round 6: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 5 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 49 loops.

Round 7: Change to A. *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 6 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 56 loops.

Round 8: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 7 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 63 loops.

Round 9: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 8 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 70 loops.

Round 10: Change to B. *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 9 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 77 loops.

Round 11: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 10 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 84 loops.

Round 12: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 11 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 91 loops.

Round 13: Change to A. *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 12 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 98 loops.

Round 14: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 13 loops; repeat from * around – you'll have 105 loops.

Round 15: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 14 loops; repeat from * around – 112 loops.

Round 16: Change to B. *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 15 loops; repeat from * around – 119 loops.

Round 17: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 16 loops; repeat from * around – 119 loops.

Round 18: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 17 loops; repeat from * around – 126 loops.

Round 19: Change to A. *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 18 loops; repeat from * around – 133 loops.

Round 20: *Pull up 2 loops in next loop, pull up 1 loop in each of next 19 loops; repeat from * around – 140 loops.

Last Round: *Pull up 1 loop in each of next 4 loops, pull up 2 loops in next loop; rep from * around.

FINISH YOUR RUG

Now you'll need to finish off your loops. Drop the working yarn.

Working in the same direction as the last round you made, pull the second loop through the first; pull the third loop through the second; pull the fourth through the third – and so on across to the end of the round.

Now you're back to the working yarn. Cut the working yarn, leaving a yarn tail with about 4-5 loops. Carefully snip these remaining loops off the working yarn tail. Pull working yarn through the last loop and knot.

Carefully snip the remaining loops from each yarn tail. Just snip the loops off, don't cut through the yarn! Pull each of the trimmed tails through the loops of the Rug to secure them.
