

Free Knitting Pattern LION BRAND® POUND OF LOVE® MODULAR TRIANGLE SHAWL

Pattern Number: M20299 POL



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SKILL LEVEL – INTERMEDIATE

SIZES

Finished Width About 60 in. (152.5 cm), measured across top edge.Finished Length About 30 in. (76 cm), measured from top center to lower point

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND[®] POUND OF LOVE[®] (Art. #550)
 #134 Terracotta 1 ball
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular needle size 9 (5.5 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long

GAUGE

17 sts + 25 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

One Square = about 4 3/4 x 4 3/4 in. (12 x 12 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfbf (knit into front, back and then into front again)

A double increase worked as follows:

- 1. Knit the next st through the front loop, but do not remove the st from your left hand needle.
- 2. Knit the same st again, this time inserting your needle through the back loop of the st. Do not remove the st from the left hand needle. You will have created 2 loops (sts) on your right hand needle.
- 3. Knit the same st once more, inserting needle through the front loop of the st. You will have created 3 loops (sts) on your right hand needle.
- 4. Drop the st from your left hand needle you have increased 2 sts.

MB (Make Bobble)

- 1. On RS, kfbf in next st (3 sts worked onto right needle).
- 2. On WS, turn and knit across the 3 sts.
- 3. On RS, turn and purl across the 3 sts.
- 4. On RS, Pass 3rd and then 2nd st over first st and off right needle.



sk2p (slip-k2tog-pass slipped st over)

A double decrease worked as follows:

- 1. Insert right needle as if to knit, and slip the next st from the left needle to the right needle.
- 2. Knit the next 2 sts together.
- 3. With tip of left needle, lift the slipped st (the 2nd st on right needle) up and over the k2tog (first st on right needle) and off the needle you have decreased 2 sts.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked in two sections: Upper Section and Lower Section.
- 2. Upper Section is made from 10 mitered squares and 5 mitered triangles joined together to form a large triangle. Each mitered square and triangle is worked back and forth in rows with decreases at center of each RS row. They are attached to one another in a modular fashion, as you knit. Refer to Diagram for placement of mitered squares and triangles.
- 3. Sts are picked up along diagonal edges of Upper Section to beg Lower Section. Lower Section is worked back and forth in rows, with increases wat beg, center and end of each RS row.
- 4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.

UPPER SECTION

Square I

Cast on 39 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Row 1 (RS): K18, sk2p, k18 – you will have 37 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K17, sk2p, k17 – 35 sts.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: K16, sk2p and place a marker on this center st, k16 – 33 sts. Note: Place marker on the sk2p decrease, not on the needle. Move the marker up to center st as work progresses.

Row 6: Purl.

Row 7: K to 1 st before marked center st, sk2p, k to end of row -31 sts.

Rows 8 and 9: Rep Rows 6 and 7 – 29 sts in Row 9.

Row 10: Knit.

Row 11 (Eyelet Row – RS): K1, (k2tog, yo) 6 times, sk2p, (yo, k2tog) 6 times, k1 – 27 sts.

Row 12: Knit.

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Row 13: K to 1 st before marked center st, sk2p, k to end of row – 25 sts.
Rows 14-17: Rep Rows 6 and 7 twice – 21 sts in Row 17.
Rows 18-23: Rep Rows 12 and 13 for 3 more times – 15 sts in Row 23.
Rows 24 and 25: Rep Rows 6 and 7 – 13 sts in Row 25.
Row 26: Purl.
Row 27 (Bobble Row – RS): K3, MB, k1, sk2p, k1, MB, k3 – 11 sts.
Rows 28-35: Rep Rows 6 and 7 for 4 more times – 3 sts in Row 35.
Row 36: Purl.
Row 37: Sk2p – 1 st.
Do not fasten off.

Squares II, III and IV

From RS, with last st of previous square still on needle, pick up and k19 sts evenly spaced along edge of previous square, cast on 19 sts – 39 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Rows 1-37: Work same as Rows 1-37 of Square I.

Do not fasten off.

Triangle I

From RS, with last st of previous square still on needle, pick up and k19 sts evenly spaced along edge of previous square, cast on 19 sts – 39 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Row 1 (RS): K2tog, k16, sk2p, k16, k2tog – 35 sts.

Row 2: Knit.

Row 3: K2tog, k14, sk2p and place a marker on this st, k14, k2tog – 31 sts.

Note: Place marker on the sk2p decrease, not on the needle. Move the marker up to center st as work progresses.

Row 4: Knit.

Row 5: K2tog, k to 1 st before marked center st, sk2p, k to last 2 sts, k2tog – 27 sts.

Row 6: Knit.

Row 7 (Eyelet Row - RS): K2tog, (k2tog, yo) 5 times, sk2p, (yo, k2tog) 5 times, k2tog - 23 sts.

Rows 8-17: Rep Rows 4 and 5 for 5 more times – 3 sts in Row 17.

Row 18: Knit.

Row 19: Sk2p - 1 st.

Fasten off last st.

Square V

Cast on 19 sts. From RS, pick up and k20 sts evenly spaced along edge of Square I – 39 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Rows 1-37: Work same as Rows 1-37 of Square I.

Do not fasten off.

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Squares VI and VII

From RS, with last st of previous square still on needle, pick up and k18 sts evenly spaced along edge of previous square, 1 st at center where previous square meets square from tier below, and 19 sts along edge of next square from tier below – 39 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Rows 1-37: Work same as Rows 1-37 of Square I.

Do not fasten off.

Triangle II

From RS, with last st of previous square still on needle, pick up and k18 sts evenly spaced along edge of previous square, 1 st at center where previous square meets square from tier below, and 19 sts along edge of next square from tier below – 39 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Rows 1-19: Work same as Rows 1-19 of Triangle I.

Fasten off last st.

Squares VIII and IX

Work same as Squares V and VI.

Triangle III

Work same as Triangle II.

Square X

Work same as Square V.

Triangle IV

Work same as Triangle II.

Triangle V

Cast on 19 sts. From RS, pick up and k20 sts evenly spaced along edge of square X – 39 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Rows 1-19: Work same as Rows 1-19 of Triangle I.

Fasten off last st.

LOWER SECTION

From RS, beg at one of the top corners of Upper Section, pick up and k99 sts evenly spaced along first diagonal edge of Upper Section, pick up and k1st at center point, pick up and k99 sts evenly spaced along next diagonal edge of Upper Section – 199 sts.

Set-Up Row (WS): K3, place marker (pm), k96, pm, k1 (center st), pm, k96, pm, k3. Note: Place markers on needle, not on sts. Slip markers as you come to them.

Row 1 (Increase Row – RS): K3, slip marker (sm), yo, k to next marker, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k to last marker, yo, sm, k3 – 203 sts.

Row 2: K3, sm, p to last marker, sm, k3.

Row 3: K3, sm, yo, k1, MB, k to 2 sts before next marker, MB, k1, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k1, MB, k to 2 sts before last marker, MB, k1, yo, sm, k3 – 207 sts.

Row 4: K3, sm, p to last marker, sm, k3.

Rows 5-12: Rep Rows 1-4 twice.

Row 13: Rep Row 1 – 227 sts.

Row 14: Knit.

Row 15: Rep Row 1 – 231 sts.

Row 16: Knit.

Row 17 (Eyelet Row - RS): K3, sm, yo, k1, (k2tog, yo) to 1 st before next marker, k1, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k1, (k2tog, yo) to 1 st before last marker, k1, yo, sm, k3 - 235 sts.

Rows 18-21: Rep Rows 14 and 15 twice – 243 sts in Row 21.

Rows 22-61: Rep Rows 2-21 twice – 323 sts in Row 61.

Rows 62-69: Rep Rows 14-21 – 339 sts in Row 69.

Rows 70-75: Rep Rows 14-19 – 351 sts in Row 75.

Rows 76 and 77: Knit, removing all markers.

Bind off, taking care not to bind off too tightly.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)
k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 sts together
p = purl
rep = repeat
RS = right side
st(s) = stitch(es)
St st = Stockinette stitch
WS = wrong side
