## SKILL LEVEL – EASY

## SIZES

About 12 x 113 in. (30.5 x 287 cm), blocked

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® COVER STORY (Art. #533)  
#123 Mineral 1 cake
- LION BRAND® knitting needles size 13 (9 mm)
- LION BRAND® cable needle
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## GAUGE

14 sts = about 6 in. (15 cm) over Cable Pattern.

**BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

## STITCH EXPLANATION

**2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross)** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

**2/2 RC (2 over 2 right cross)** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in back, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

**3/3 Rib LC (3 over 3 rib left cross)** Slip 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at front, k1, p1, k1, then k1, p1, k1 from cable needle.

**3/3 Rib RC (3 over 3 rib right cross)** Slip 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back, k1, p1, k1 then k1, p1, k1 from cable needle.

**RT (Right Twist)** K2tog and leave on left hand needle, then with right hand needle, go between the 2 sts and k the first st again, slip both sts from needle.

## NOTES

1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows of a Cable Pattern.
2. Cable Pattern can be worked following written instructions or following the Chart. When working from Chart, read RS rows from left to right and WS rows from right to left.

## SCARF

Cast on 28 sts.

**Set-Up Row (WS):** P4, k2, (p1, k1, p2, k1) 3 times, p1, k2, p4.

### ***Cable Pattern***

**Row 1 (RS):** 2/2 LC, p2, k1, p1, k2, p1, k1, p1, RT, p1, k1, p1, k2, p1, k1, p2, 2/2 RC.

**Row 2 and all WS Rows:** P4, k2, (p1, k1, p2, k1) 3 times, p1, k2, p4.

**Row 3:** K4, p2, k1, p1, k2, p1, 3/3 Rib RC, p1, k2, p1, k1, p2, k4.

**Row 5:** Rep Row 1.

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**Row 7:** K4, p2, 3/3 Rib RC, p1, RT, p1, 3/3 Rib LC, p2, k4.

**Row 8:** P4, k2, (p1, k1, p2, k1) 3 times, p1, k2, p4.

Rep Rows 1-8 until almost all yarn has been used and ending with a Row 8 as the last row you work.

*Bind off loosely.*

## FINISHING

### Blocking

Soak Scarf in lukewarm water with a small amount of wool wash for about 15 minutes. Squeeze out excess water, then lay Scarf onto towel and roll it gently to remove additional water. Lay Scarf flat onto dry towels and shape to finished measurements. Allow to dry.

*Weave in ends.*

**k** = knit

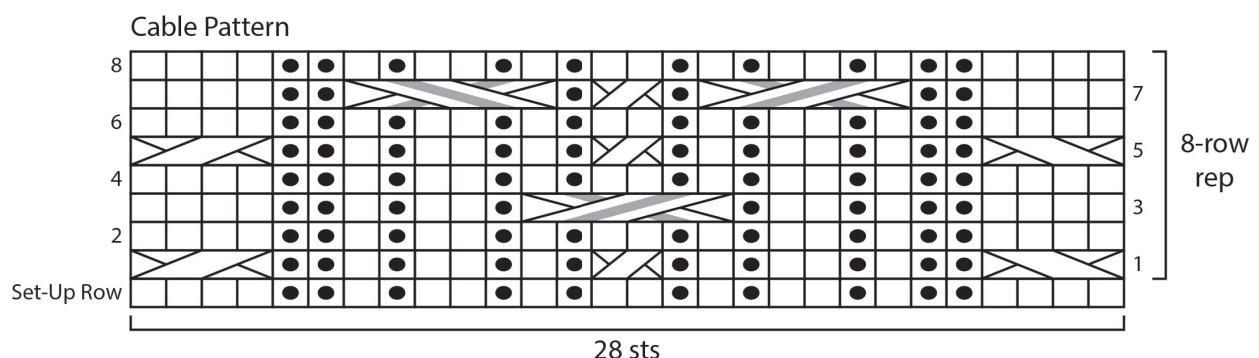
**p** = purl

**rep** = repeat

**RS** = right side

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**WS** = wrong side
