

Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® LION'S PRIDE® WOOLSPUN® POCKET SHAWL

Pattern Number: M20295 WS



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SKILL LEVEL – INTERMEDIATE

SIZES

About 21 x 57 in. (53.5 x 145 cm), not including fringe

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND[®] LION'S PRIDE[®] WOOLSPUN[®] (Art. #671)
 #142 Burgundy 3 balls (A)
 #123 Taupe 3 balls (B)
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size L-11 (8 mm)

GAUGE

10 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-7. **BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

1/1 FPdc-FC (1 over 1 Front Post double crochet font cross) Sk next st, FPdc around next st; working *in front of* FPdc just made, FPdc around skipped st,

3/3 FPtr-BC (3 over 3 Front Post treble crochet back cross) Sk next 3 sts, FPtr around each of next 3 sts; working *behind* the FPtr sts just made, FPtr around each of 3 skipped sts

3/3 FPtr-FC (3 over 3 Front Post treble crochet front cross) Sk next 3 sts, FPtr around each of next 3 sts; working *in front of* FPtr sts just made, FPtr around each of 3 skipped sts

BPdc (Back Post double crochet) Yarn over, insert hook from back to front then to back, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip top of st *in front of* the BPdc.

FPdc (Front Post double crochet) Yarn over, insert hook from front to back then to front, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) twice. Skip top of st *behind* the FPdc.

FPtr (Front Post treble crochet) Yarn over twice, insert hook from front to back then to front again, going around post of indicated st, draw up a loop, (yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook) 3 times. Skip top of st *behind* the FPtr.

NOTES

1. Shawl is made in 5 pieces: Center Triangle, 2 Side Panels, and 2 Pockets. The Center Triangle and Side Panels are sewn together following a Diagram, to form a long rectangle and Pockets are sewn to each end of rectangle.



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- 2. Center Triangle is worked back and forth in a pattern of 3 rows of (sc, ch 1) and 1 row of (tr, ch 1).
- 3. Each Side Panel is worked the same as Center Triangle for first 21 rows. Then rows are worked back and forth over one side edge of the triangle only to shape side extensions.
- 4. Pockets are worked back and forth in a cable pattern.

CENTER TRIANGLE

Wrap A around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Rnd 1 into the ring.

Row 1: Ch 1, work 5 sc in ring; work back and forth in rows, do not join to form round.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as tr, ch 1), turn, tr in first st, ch 1, (tr, ch 1, tr) in next st, ch 1, (tr, ch 2, tr) in next st, (ch 1, (tr, ch 1, tr) in next st) twice – you will have 10 tr, 8 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp (5 tr and 2 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp).

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as sc, ch 1), turn, sk first st, * sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in center ch-2 sp, ch 1, sk next st, ** sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from ** to beg ch-sp, sc in beg ch-sp, ch 1, sc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 12 sc, 10 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp (6 sc and 5 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp).

Rows 4 and 5: Ch 2 (counts as sc, ch 1), turn, sk first st, * sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in center ch-2 sp, ch 1, sk next st, ** sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from ** to beg ch-sp, sc in beg ch-sp, ch 1, sc in 1st ch of beg ch – 16 sc, 14 ch-1 sps, and 1 center ch-2 sp (8 sc and 7 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp) in Row 5.

Row 6: Ch 4 (counts as tr, ch 1), turn, * tr in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, (tr, ch 2, tr) in center ch-2 sp, ch 1, sk next st, ** tr in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from ** to beg ch-sp, tr in beg ch-sp, ch 1, tr in first ch of beg ch – 9 tr and 8 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.

Row 7: Rep Row 3 – 10 sc and 9 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.

Rows 8 and 9: Rep Rows 4 and 5 – 12 sc and 11 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp in Row 9

Rows 10-29: Rep Rows 6-9 for 5 more times – 32 sc, 31 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp) in Row 29. *Fasten off*

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SIDE PANELS (make 2)

With B, make same as Center Triangle through Row 21 – 24 sc, 23 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp) in Row 21.

Side Extension

Row 22: Ch 4 (counts as tr, ch 1), turn, * tr in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, tr in center ch-2 sp; leave rem sts unworked – 25 tr and 24 ch-1 sps.

Rows 23-25: Ch 2 (counts as sc, ch 1), turn, sk first st, * sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * to beg ch-sp, sc in beg ch-sp – 25 sc and 24 ch-1 sps in each row.

Row 26: Ch 4 (counts as tr, ch 1), turn, * tr in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * to beg ch-sp, tr in beg ch-sp.

Rows 27-29: Rep Rows 23-25.

Fasten off.

POCKETS (make 2)

Ribbing

With A, ch 6.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 5 sc in this row.

Rows 2-19: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across.

Cable Pattern

Row 1 (WS): Ch 2 (does not count as a dc), do not turn; working along side edge, dc in end of each row of ribbing – 19 dc.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in first 2 sts, 1/1 FPdc-FC, dc in next st, 3/3 FPtr-FC, FPdc around each of next 3 sts, dc in next st, 1/1 FPdc-FC, dc in last 2 sts (leave beg ch-2 unworked).

Row 3: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in first 2 sts, BPdc around each of next 2 sts, dc in next st, BPdc around each of next 9 sts, dc in next st, BPdc around each of next 2 sts, dc in last 2 sts.

Row 4: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, dc in first 2 sts, 1/1 FPdc-FC, dc in next st, FPdc around each of next 3 sts, 3/3 FPtr-BC, dc in next st, 1/1 FPdc-FC, dc in last 2 sts.

Row 5: Rep Row 3.

Rows 6-13: Rep Rows 2-5.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Wet block all pieces to measurements shown in Diagram.

Center Triangle: About 45 in. (114.5 cm) along longest edge x 29 in. (73.5 cm) along each side edge.

Each Side Panel: About 30 in. (76 cm) along longest edge x 28 1/2 in. (72.5 cm) along next longest edge x 21 in. (53.5 cm) along next edge x 6 in. (15 cm) along shortest edge.

Each Pocket: About 8 x 8 in. (20.5 x 20.5 cm).

Sew pieces together following Diagram.

Place lower edge of Pockets centered over Row 25 of side extension and with top opening facing towards center of Shawl. Sew Pockets in place along sides and lower edge, leaving the top edge open.

Weave in ends.

Fringe

Cut 110 strands of B and 23 strands of A, about 10 1/4 in. (26 cm) long.

Make a fringe in every other st across one short edge, alternating a fringe made with 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B with a fringe made with 3 strands of A.

To make each fringe, hold the 3 strands of yarn together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of piece, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Trim fringe evenly.


Rep to attach fringe along other short edge.
