

# Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® GO FOR FAUX THICK & QUICK-TRUBOO WOLVERINE SLIPPERS

Pattern Number: M20302 GFTQ TB



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#### **SKILL LEVEL – INTERMEDIATE**

#### **SIZES**

1(2,3)

To fit shoe sizes Child 10-3 (Woman 6-8, Woman 9-11)

Finished Length 6 (8, 10) in. (15 (20.5, 25.5) cm), unstretched. Slippers are stretchy and will fit a range of sizes

**Notes:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### **MATERIALS**

LION BRAND® GO FOR FAUX THICK & QUICK (Art. #323)

#223 Lynx 3 (3, 4) balls (A)

LION BRAND® TRUBOO (Art. #837)

#157 Yellow 1 ball (B)

#123 Tan 1 ball (C)

- LION BRAND® crochet hook size P-15 (10 mm) (for head)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size F-5 (3.75 mm) (for facial details)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

#### ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

- Crochet hook size 12mm (for slippers)
- Black embroidery thread (for nose)
- Small amount of fiberfill stuffing
- 2 pair of safety eyes, 10mm diameter
- Sewing needle and strong sewing thread.

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#### **GAUGE**

5 ch with yarn A = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### IMPORTANT NOTE

The head and features are worked separately and then sewn to the Slippers. Be sure to sew very firmly, using strong thread. These sewn-on pieces can be choking hazards. Do not leave Slippers unattended with a small child, do not allow a child to play with the Slippers.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

#### NOTES

- 1. Each Slipper is worked in 9 pieces: Slipper, Head, 2 Face pieces, 2 Eye Patches, Snout, and 2 Ears.
- 2. Face pieces, Eye Patches, Snout, and Ears are all sewn to Head, safety eyes are attached, then Head is sewn to Slipper.
- 3. There are separate instructions provided for the smallest size (size 1) and the 2 larger sizes (sizes 2 and 3).
- 4. Only a small amount of yarns B and C are needed.
- 5. Slippers are slippery and not meant for use on uncarpeted floors. If you'd like to try and make the slippers a bit more stable, trace sole of finished slipper onto a piece of faux leather or suede. Cut out shape and with sewing needle and thread. Whipstitch a leather sole onto each slipper.

#### **SIZE 1 ONLY**

#### SLIPPERS (make 2)

With largest hook and A, ch 7.

**Rnd 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 4 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 4 ch, 2 sc in last ch – you will have 14 sc in this rnd.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Make 2 sc in first st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next 3 sts, sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in last 2 sts – 20 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: Sc in first 4 sts, (sc2tog) 5 times, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog – 14 sc.

Rnds 5 and 6: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

# HEAD (make 2 - 1 for each Slipper)

With middle size hook and A, ch 4.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 3 sc.

Rows 2-6: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

Fold in half. With yarn tail, sew the short edges together.

# FACE (make 4-2 for each Head)

With smallest hook and C, ch 8.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across -7 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog – 5 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog – 3 sc.

Fasten off.

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# EYE PATCH (make 4 – 2 for each Head)

With smallest hook and B, ch 5.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 4 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) 2 times – 2 sc.

Fasten off.

# SNOUT (make 2 – 1 for each Head)

With smallest hook and C, ch 4.

**Rnd 1:** Working in back bumps only, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next ch, 2 sc in last ch - 8 sc.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Make 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next 3 sts, sc in next st, 2 sc in last 2 sts – 14 sc.

Rnd 3: Make 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 2 times – 20 sts.

Rnds 4 and 5: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

# EARS (make 4 - 2 for each Head)

With smallest hook and C, ch 2.

**Rnd 1:** Make 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook – 6 sc.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Make 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc.

Rnd 3: [2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times – 18 sc.

Fold in half, sc the front and back sides together loosely.

Wrap a length of A around the stitches of the loose last row.

#### **FINISHING**

Stack one Eye Patch on top of each Face piece and follow package directions to attach a safety eye through both layers.

With doubled strong sewing thread, sew Eyes, Ears, and Snout to each Head, stuffing the Snout as you sew.

With black embroidery thread, embroider a straight stitch nose.

Using strong sewing thread and sewing very firmly, sew a Head to each Slipper.

Weave in yarn ends.

# SIZES 2 (3) ONLY

#### SLIPPERS (make 2)

With largest hook and A, ch 10 (12).

**Rnd 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 7 (9) ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 7 (9) ch, 2 sc in the last ch – you will have 20 (24) sc in this rnd.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

**Rnd 2:** Make 2 sc in first st, sc in next 7 (9) sts, 2 sc in next 3 sts, sc in next 7 (9) sts, 2 sc in last 2 sts – 26 (30) sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: Sc in first 7 (9) sts, (sc2tog) 5 times, sc in next 7 (9) sts, sc2tog – 20 (24) sc

**Rnd 5:** Sc2tog, sc in next 3 (5) sts, (sc2tog) 2 times, sc in next st, (sc2tog) 2 times, sc in next 3 (5) sts, sc2tog, sc last st - 14 (18) sc.

**Rnd 6:** Sc2tog, sc in next 2 (4) sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next 2 (4) sts, sc2tog, sc in last st - 10 (14) sc.

Rnd 7: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off.

Weave in yarn ends.

# HEAD (make 2 – 1 for each Slipper)

With middle size hook and A, ch 5.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 4 sc.

Rows 2-8: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Fold in half. With yarn tail, sew the short edges together.

# LEFT FACE (make 2 – 1 for each Head)

With smallest hook and C, ch 10.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 9 sc.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog – 7 sc.

Row 7: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next st, (sc2tog) 2 times - 4 sc.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) 2 times – 2 sc.

Fasten off.

# RIGHT FACE (make 2 – 1 for each Head)

With smallest hook and C, ch 10.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across -9 sc.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog – 7 sc.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) 2 times, sc in next st, sc2tog – 4 sc.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) 2 times – 2 sc.

Fasten off.

# EYE PATCH (make 4 – 2 for each Head)

With smallest hook and B, ch 7.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across – 6 sc.

Rows 2-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog – 4 sc.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, turn, (sc2tog) 2 times – 2 sc.

Fasten off.

# SNOUT (make 2 – 1 for each Head)

With smallest hook and C, ch 4.

**Rnd 1:** Working in back bumps only, Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next ch, 2 sc in last ch - 8 sc.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Make 2 sc in first st, sc in next st, 2 sc in next 3 sts, sc in next st, 2 sc in last 2 sts - 14 sc.

Rnd 3: Make 2 sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 3 times, sc in next st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 2 times – 20 sts.

Rnd 4: Make 2 sc in first st, sc in next 3 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 3 times, sc in next st, (2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 2 times – 26 sts.

Rnds 5-7: Sc in each st around

Fasten off.

# EARS (make 4 – 2 for each Head)

With smallest hook and C, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Make 6 Sc in 2nd ch from hook - 6 sc.

Place a marker in last sc made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Make 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: [2 sc in next st, sc in next st] 6 times – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** [2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts] 6 times – 24 sc.

Fold in half, sc the front and back side together **loosely**.

Wrap a length of A around the stitches of the loose last row.

#### **FINISHING**

Stack one Eye Patch on top of each Face piece and attach a safety eye through both layers.

Sew Left and Right Faces together.

With doubled strong sewing thread, sew Eyes, Ears, and Snout to each Head, stuffing the Snout as you sew.

With black embroidery thread, embroider a straight stitch nose.

Sew a Head to each Slipper.

Weave in yarn ends.
