GRAPE VARIETY

100% Bacchus

VINEYARDS

The Bacchus grapes are sourced from Kent vineyards, including Aylesford and Lamberhurst.

WINEMAKING

A good growing season in 2017 led to high quality Bacchus grapes. This wine is always made by selecting the fruit from the best vineyards each year to give the richest and ripest style of Bacchus. The fruit was whole bunch pressed and only the first juice used to maintain a purity in profile.

ANALYSIS

ABV: 12.5%

Residual Sugar: 2.9 g/l

pH: 3.13

TA: 7.2 g/l

TASTING NOTES

This limited production wine has intense aromas of gooseberry, nettle and melon. Tropical fruits are distinctive on the palate and balanced acidity leads to a long finish.

SERVING SUGGESTION

A great match with Thai and Chinese cuisine. Alternatively, try with roast pork and apple sauce! Enjoy this wine at its optimum between now and 2020. An ideal alternative to New World Sauvignon Blanc.
