### GRAPE VARIETY

100% Bacchus

### VINEYARDS

Fruit is sourced from vineyards in Kent, East Sussex and Essex. Grapes are grown predominantly on single and double guyot pruning systems, on varied soils including, chalk, clay and loam soils.

### WINEMAKING

Grapes were hand-picked and whole-bunch pressed in September and October 2019. Cool fermentation in stainless steel with no malolactic fermentation helps to retain the freshness of this style.

### ANALYSIS (pre bottling)

ABV: 12%

RS: 10.3 g/l

pH: 3.16

TA: 7.9 g/l

### TASTING NOTES

Aromas of pineapple, grapefruit and elderflower. The gentle effervescence carries the tropical fruit and floral flavours giving a crisp refreshing finish.

### SERVING SUGGESTION

Great as an aperitif or the perfect pairing to summer salads and grilled poultry. Best consumed within one year of purchase.
