

Exhibition:Paule Vezelay: Living Lines

Living Lines

Living Lines brings to life the work of pioneering British artist Paule Vezelay (born Marjorie Watson-Williams, 1892-1984). Critically forgotten, the exhibition provides the first opportunity in 40 years (since an exhibition at Tate in 1983) to reassess Vezelay's considerable contribution to British and European art.

This exhibition includes painting, drawing, sculpture, print, textile and archival material. Including key works from public collections and the artist's estate, it takes a chronological approach spanning Vezelay's life (spent between Bristol, London and Paris), interweaving artwork and archive to provide an intimate insight that restores the artist's reputation to that of her contemporaries.

The exhibition will tour to other UK venues during 2025 and includes work from other artists including Barbara Hepworth, Alexander Calder and Marlow Moss.

There will be an accompanying coffee table publication with images of artwork and archival material.
