


Easy DIY fluid art: Creating cells







Ocean flip cup pour with cells #1

1. Filling the cup

The secret to cells is mixing silicone oil in with the paint.

For this first pour I'm using 3 blue tones; Ultramarine, Cerulean Blue and Light blue as well as Titanium White.

Fill each cup with 200mls of each colour.

Squeeze approximatly 10ml of Mont Marte silicone oil in each cup and throughy mix it through the paint.

Use another cup and create alternate layers of each of your mixed colours until the level is just below the brim.

2. Fliping the cup

Lay a 30x30cm painting board face down onto the cup and flip them both over. Gently lift the cup and slowly tilt the board back and forth until the board is totally covered by the pouring paint.

You will notice the cells will form by themselves.



Fluid art can be messy so ensure all of your surfaces are covered with some sort of drop sheet. A heat torch can be used to promote cells.







Colourful flip cup pour with cells # 2

1. Filling the cups

Fill each cup with 200mls of the colours below.

Mint Green, Bright Yellow, Aquamarine Blue, Shiraz, and Dark Purple and Titanium white.

Squeeze approximatly 10ml of Mont Marte silicone oil in each cup and throughy mix it through the paint.

Use another cup and create alternate layers of each of your mixed colours until the level is just below the brim.

To generate more cells pour the paint into the cup from a height to break the surface of the top layer of paint in the cup. This way the colours will mix through the paint more freely creating more of a variance of colours in the pour.

2. Fliping the cup

Lay a 50x60cm canvas face down onto the cup and flip them both over. Gently lift the cup and slowly tilt the board back and forth until the board is totally covered by the pouring paint.

You will notice the cells will form by themselves.
