

Paper Snow Flake Chains

What You Will Need:

- White Paper
- Or White Card
- Tape
- String
- Scissors - with an adult supervision!

Step By Step Guide:

1. Start with a square piece of paper. To cut a square from a regular sheet of paper, fold one corner down, like a triangle, and trim off the excess paper
2. Take your square and fold it diagonally in half to create a triangle
3. Fold your triangle in half to make a smaller triangle
4. Divide the resulting triangle into 3 equal parts
5. If you want to be super precise, use a protractor and measure three 30° angles
6. Once you identified your sections, fold the left side towards the back and repeat with the right side
7. Now, it is time to draw the snowflake pattern and cut it.
8. Make sure to leave the left and right sides connected at some point so the snowflake doesn't fall apart when cutting
9. Carefully unfold your paper to reveal your snowflake
10. Put them under a book for a couple of minutes to make them lay flat, or iron them at the lowest settings
