

How to colour in your Carnation bouquet, Birth Flower for January, in 5 easy stages

STAGE 1

We begin this bright bouquet by adding gradual layers to build up colour and tone as we go.




STAGE 2

First we add a colour base of greens to add tone to the stems and leaves, and some defining shade.



STAGE 3

Next we build up the flower heads with layers of varying pinks, applying deeper tones to increase the density.



STAGE 4

Time to bring some life into this bouquet with an all-over splash of colour and deepening shades.



STAGE 5

Almost there! Some subtle blending and final details and these January Carnations have reached their flowery fruition.

Carnation is a common name for a herbaceous plant, *Dianthus caryophyllus*, of the *Caryophyllaceae* family, widely cultivated for its flowers.

Border carnations are among the most popular, whether in gardens or as cut flowers included in floral arrangements and corsages.
