STAGE 2

First we add a colour base of yellows and golds to add tone to the petals with a little defining shade.



STAGE 4

Now an all-over splash of colour and deepening shade to add some vitality to this pretty bouquet.



STAGE 1

We begin this Spring bouquet with the linework, adding gradual layers to build up colour and tone as we go.



STAGE 3

Next we build up the drawing with further layers, adding green to the stems, and applying darker tones to increase the density.



STAGE 5

Nearly there! After some subtle blending and final details this trumpeting array of Spring Daffodils is ready to give out its joy.
