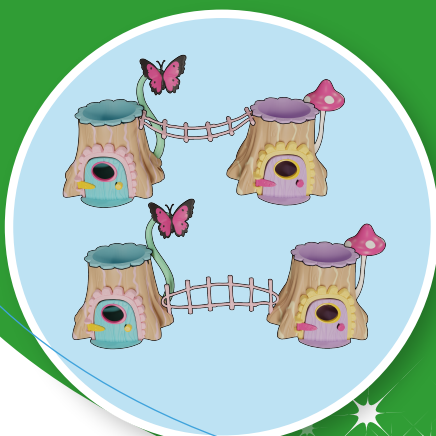
1. Remove the planter from the tree trunk.

2. Place the paper growing mat in the planter or carefully fill the planter with soil.



3. Scatter the Red Amaranth Seeds evenly over the soil or paper mat and carefully water the seeds.... but don't add too much water.

4. Place the planter somewhere safe and light (perhaps a windowsill) until the Red Amaranth has grown 5-7 cm tall – either on its own or inside the tree trunk. Note – It's best to keep them covered from the light initially while germinating (2-3 days)



5. You can connect the different Fairy Forest homes together using the fences in two different ways.



6. Collect the whole Fairy Forest Friends range and create a magical fairy forest village by connecting them together.
