LION BRAND® SUNSET NIGHTS
ELLA TIED CARDIGAN

Pattern Number: M20402 SUN



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

S (M, L, 1X, 2X)

Finished Bust 36 (42, 45, 51, 53) in. (91.5 (106.5, 114.5, 129.5, 134.5) cm)

Finished Length 26 (27, 28, 29, 30) in. (66 (68.5, 71, 73.5, 76) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® SUNSET NIGHTS (Art. #507)
#607 Martha's Vineyard 5 (6, 7, 7, 8) balls
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

9 V-sts + 13 rows = about 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm) in V-st pattern.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

V-st (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st or sp.

PATTERN STITCH

V-st Pattern

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Rep Row 1 for V-st pattern.

NOTES

1. Cardigan is made in 6 pieces: Back, 2 Fronts, 2 Sleeves and a Belt.
2. Back, Fronts and Sleeves are worked back and forth in rows of V-st pattern from lower edge upwards.
3. Belt is worked back and forth in rows of sc worked in back loops only.
4. A collar extension is worked as part of each Front. Ends of collar extensions are sewn together and lower edge is sewn to back neck to form collar.

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BACK

Ch 78 (90, 96, 108, 114).

Row 1 (RS): V-st in 6th ch from hook (5 skipped ch count as 2 base ch and first dc), *sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from * to last 3 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in last ch – you will have 24 (28, 30, 34, 36) V-sts, 1 dc at beg, and 1 dc at end of this row.

Work in V-st pattern for a total of 36 (36, 38, 38, 40) rows from beg.

Fasten off.

Shape Armholes

Row 1 (RS): From RS, draw up a loop in 2nd dc of 2nd (3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th) V-st, ch 3 (counts as dc), V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st to last 2 (3, 4, 5, 6, 7) V-sts, dc in first dc of next V-st; leave remaining sts unworked – 20 (22, 22, 24, 24) V-sts.

Work in V-st pattern for a total of 16 (18, 18, 20, 20) rows from beg of armhole shaping.

Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Ch 60 (66, 69, 75, 78).

Row 1 (RS): V-st in 6th ch from hook (5 skipped ch count as 2 base ch and first dc), *sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from * to last 3 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in last ch – you will have 18 (20, 21, 23, 24) V-sts, 1 dc at beg, and 1 dc at end of this row.

Work in V-st pattern for a total of 36 (36, 38, 38, 40) rows from beg.

Fasten off.

Shape Armhole

Row 1 (RS): From RS, draw up a loop in 2nd dc of 2nd (3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th) V-st, ch 3 (counts as dc), V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, dc in top of beg ch – 16 (17, 17, 18, 18) V-sts.

Work in V-st pattern for a total of 16 (18, 18, 20, 20) rows from beg of armhole shaping.

Fasten off.

Collar Extension

Row 1 (RS): From RS, draw up a loop in 2nd dc of 7th (8th, 8th, 9th, 9th) V-st, ch 3 (counts as dc), V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, dc in top of beg ch – 9 V-sts.

Rows 2-6: Work in V-st pattern for 5 rows.

Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Ch 60 (66, 69, 75, 78).

Row 1 (RS): V-st in 6th ch from hook (5 skipped ch count as 2 base ch and first dc), *sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from * to last 3 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in last ch – you will have 18 (20, 21, 23, 24) V-sts, 1 dc at beg, and 1 dc at end of this row.

Work in V-st pattern for a total of 36 (36, 38, 38, 40) rows from beg.

Do not fasten off.

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Shape Armhole

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st to last 2 (3, 4, 5, 6) V-sts, dc in first dc of next V-st; leave remaining sts unworked – 16 (17, 17, 18, 18) V-sts.

Work in V-st pattern for a total of 16 (18, 18, 20, 20) rows from beg of armhole shaping.

Collar Extension

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, V-st in ch-1 sp of next 9 V-sts, dc in first dc of next V-st; leave remaining sts unworked – 9 V-sts.

Rows 2-6: Work in V-st pattern for 5 rows.

Fasten off.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Ch 33 (33, 39, 39, 45).

Row 1 (RS): V-st in 6th ch from hook (5 skipped ch count as 2 base ch and first dc), *sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from * to last 3 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in last ch – you will have 9 (9, 11, 11, 13) V-sts, 1 dc at beg, and 1 dc at end of this row.

Row 2 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first dc (increase made), V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, 2 dc in 3rd ch of beg ch (increase made) – 9 (9, 11, 11, 13) V-sts, 2 dc at beg and 2 dc at end.

Row 3 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first dc, dc in next dc, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, dc in next dc, 2 dc in top of beg ch – 9 (9, 11, 11, 13) V-sts, 3 dc at beg and 3 dc at end.

Row 4 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk next st, V-st in next dc, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, sk 2nd dc of last V-st, V-st in next dc, sk next dc, dc in top of beg ch – 11 (11, 13, 13, 15) V-sts, 1 dc at beg, and 1 dc at end.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, V-st in ch-1 sp of each V-st across, dc in top of beg ch.

Rows 6-29 (33, 29, 33, 29): Rep Rows 2-5 for 6 (7, 6, 7, 6) times – 23 (25, 25, 27, 27) V-sts, 1 dc at beg, and 1 dc at end.

Work in V-st pattern until piece measures about 20 (20 1/2, 21, 21 1/2, 22) in. (51 (52, 53.5, 53.5, 56) cm) from beg.

Fasten off.

BELT

Ch 8.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 7 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 60 in. (152.5 cm) or desired length.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew shoulder seams.

Sew ends of collar extensions together for back neck.

Sew edge of seamed collar extensions to back neck edge of Cardigan.

Sew in Sleeves.

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Sleeve Edging

From RS, join yarn with sl st in wrist edge of one Sleeve.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc evenly around edge; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Rep edging around wrist edge of second Sleeve.

Cardigan Edging

From RS, join yarn with a sl st in lower right front corner.

Rnd 1: Work sc evenly spaced all the way around outside edge of Cardigan, working 2 sc in each corner; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.

ch-space(s) = chain space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

rnd = round

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side

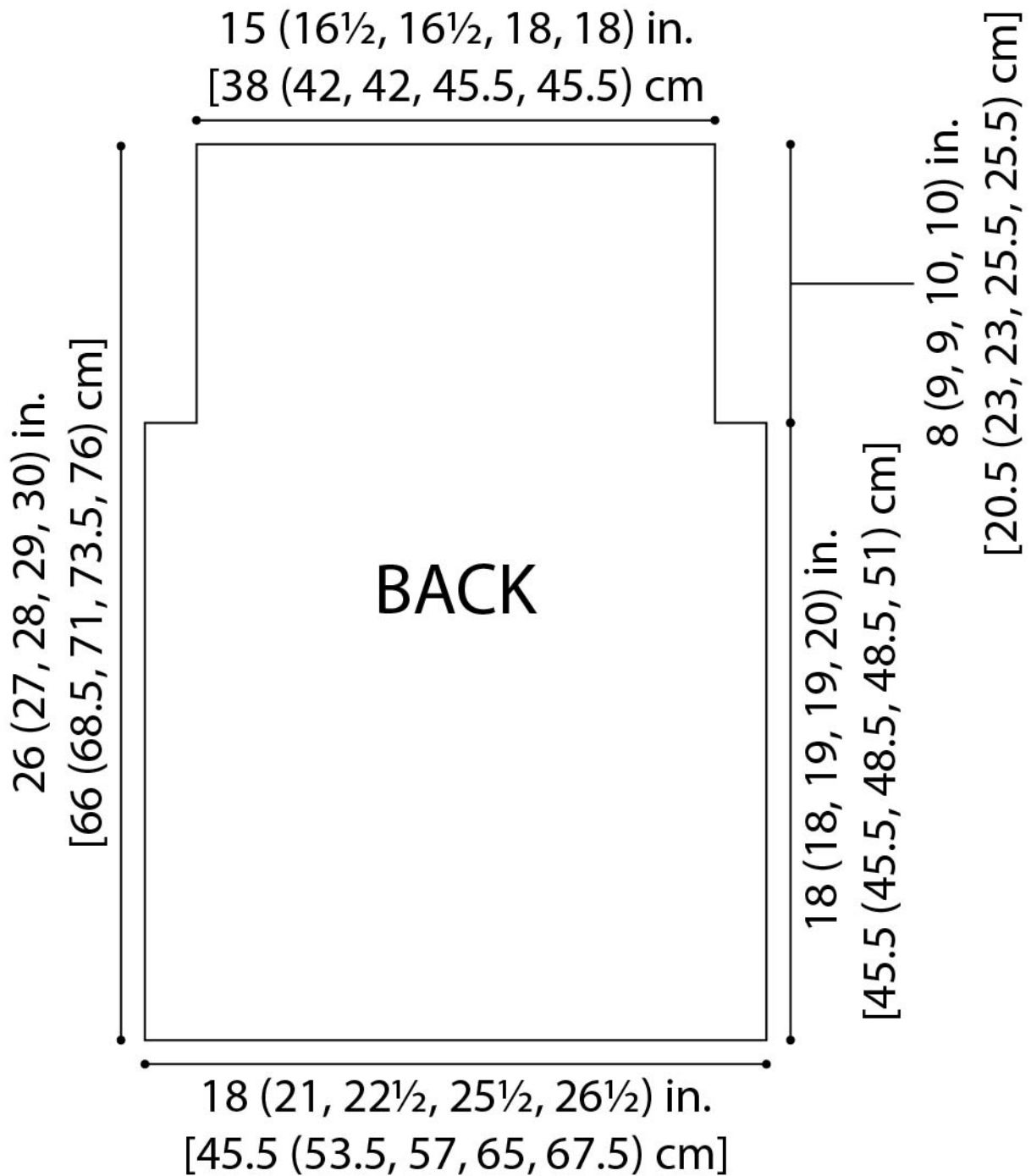
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Schematic Back

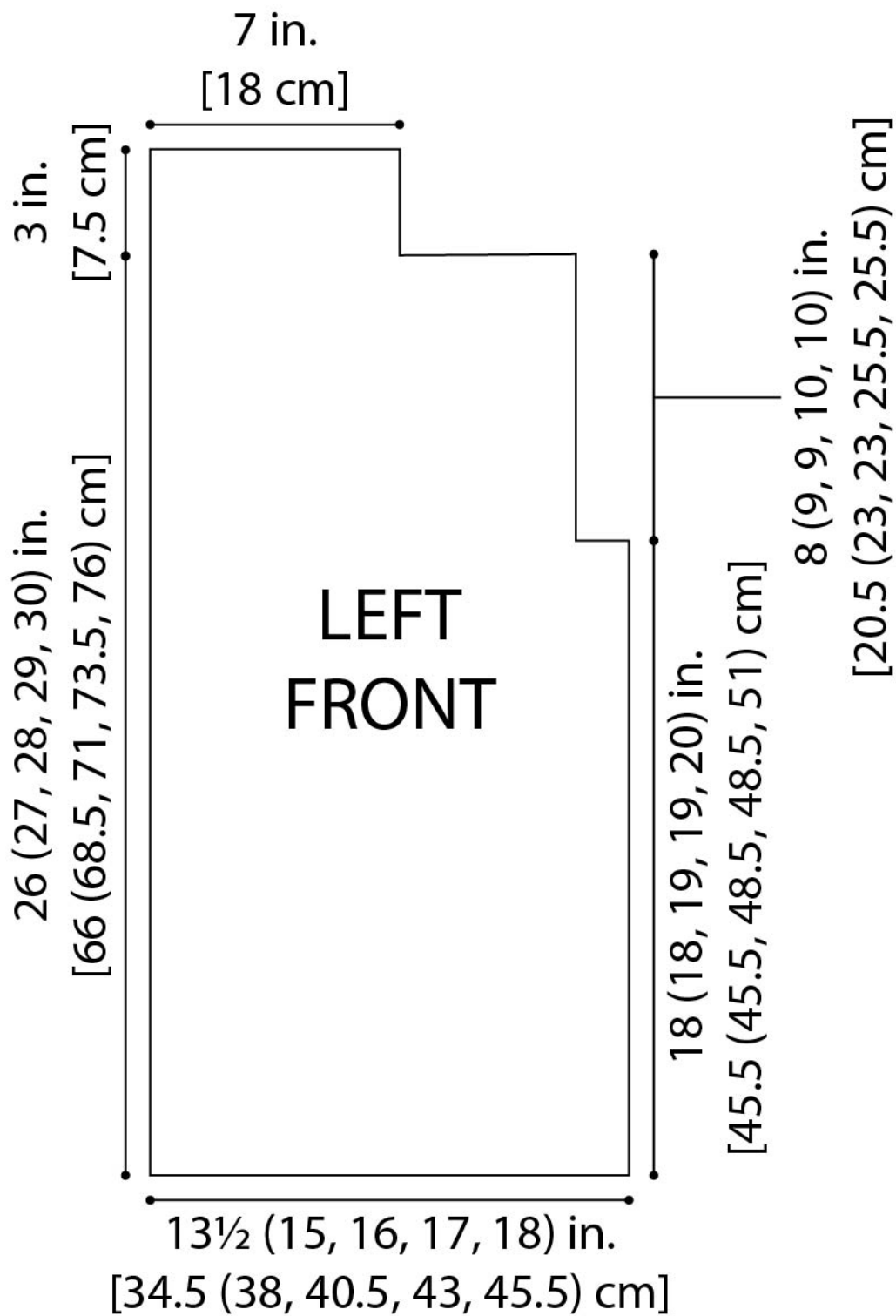


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Schematic Left

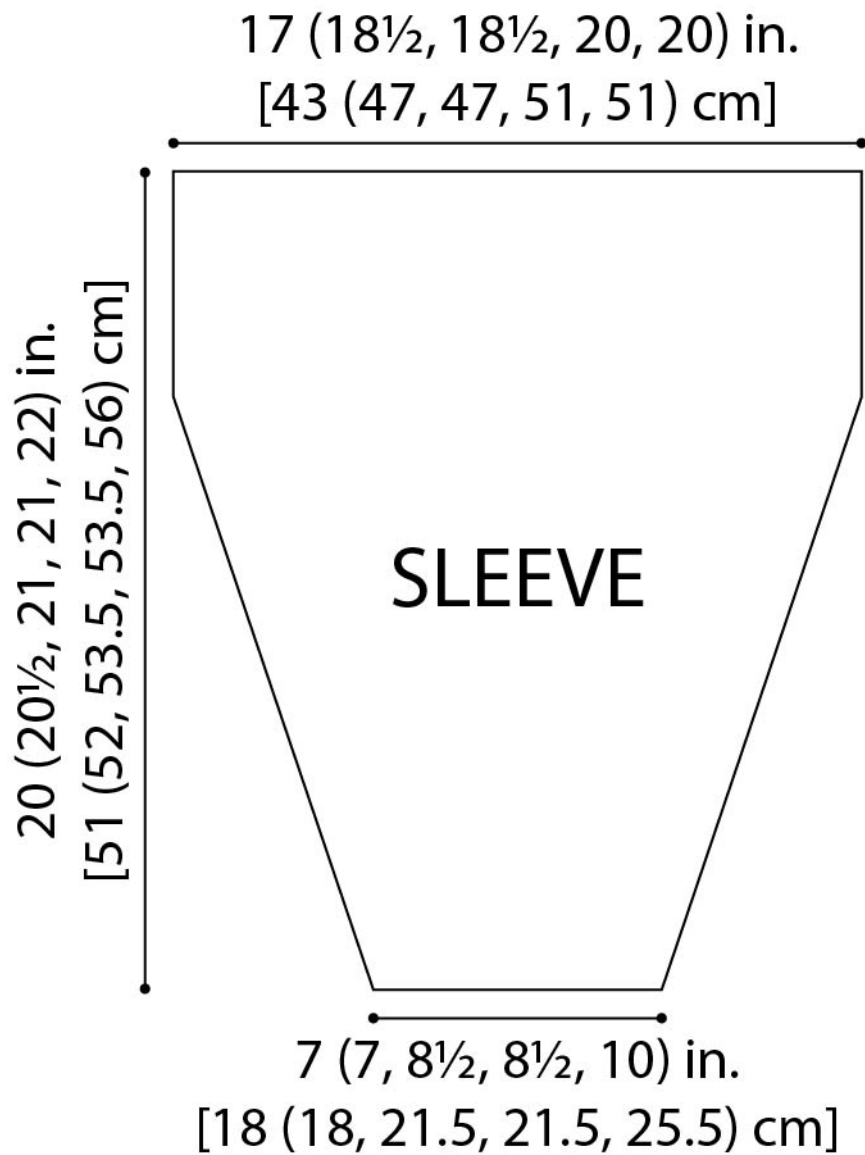


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Schematic Sleeve



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
