



Free Crochet Pattern
LION BRAND® SUNSET NIGHTS
ARIADNE SHAWL

Pattern Number: M20405 SUN



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

Finished Wingspan About 78 in. (198 cm) measured along top edge, not including tassels

Finished Length About 36 in. (91.5 cm) measured from center top edge down to center point, not including tassel

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® SUNSET NIGHTS (Art. #507)
#606 Zanzibar 5 cakes
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

7 in. (18 cm) square piece of heavy cardboard (for making tassels)

GAUGE

16 dc + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT

STITCH EXPLANATION

Puff (5-hdc puff – worked all in one st) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, (yarn over, insert hook in same st, yarn over and draw up a loop) 4 times, yarn over, draw through all 11 loops on hook, ch 1 to close puff

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked back and forth in rows from center top edge downwards.
2. Increases are worked at the beg, center, and end of each row to shape Shawl.
3. Tassels are attached to all 3 points of the finished Shawl. Tassels are made first so that all of remaining yarn can be used for the Shawl.

TASSELS (make 3)

Wrap yarn around 7 in. (18 cm) cardboard 50 times. Cut an 18 in. (45.5 cm) length of yarn and thread into blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard; do not cut the tie, it will be used to tie Tassel to Shawl.

Cut an 18 in. (45.5 cm) length of yarn and wrap tightly around loops 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) below top knot to form Tassel neck. Knot securely; thread ends into needle and weave ends to center of Tassel.

Trim Tassel ends evenly.

SHAWL

Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the stitches of Row 1 into the ring.

Row 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc) (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ring – you will have 6 dc and 1 center ch-2 sp in this row.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in next 2 sts, (Puff, ch 2, puff) in center ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 sts, 3 dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3 – 10 dc, 2 Puffs, and a center ch-2 sp (5 dc and 1 Puff on each side of center ch-2 sp).

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, dc in each dc to first Puff, dc in Puff, (Puff, ch 2, Puff) in center ch-2 sp, dc in next Puff, dc in each dc to beg ch-3, 3 dc in sp between last dc and beg ch-3 – 16 dc, 2 Puffs, and a center ch-2 sp (8 dc and 1 Puff on each side of center ch-2 sp).

Repeat Row 3 until there is not enough yarn to work another full row.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Tie one Tassel to each point of Shawl.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

ch-sp = chain space previously made

dc = double crochet

sp = space

st(s) = stitch(es)
