

Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® COTTON-EASE® PAULA PATCHWORK SCARF

Pattern Number: M21062 CE



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SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 11 1/4 x 68 in. (28.5 x 172.5 cm), not including fringe

MATERIALS

LION BRAND® COTTON-EASE® (Art. #829)

#098 Alabaster 2 balls (A)

#171 Amber 1 ball (B)

#110 Indigo 1 ball (C)

#158 Goldenrod 1 ball (D)

#126 Cocoa 1 ball (E)

#114 Redwood 1 ball (F)

- LION BRAND® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

17 sc + 16 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- Scarf is worked back and forth in rows, changing yarn color following Chart.
- 2. Each box on Chart represents one single crochet (sc) worked with the indicated yarn. Read odd-numbered rows from right to left and even-numbered rows from left to right.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Do not cut old color. When not in use, carry A along tops of sts of previous row and work sts of current row over the top of the carried strand. When not in use, leave B, C, D, E, and F on WS of piece and pick strand up again when needed in next row.
- 4. Fringe is added to both short ends of completed Scarf.

SCARF

With B, ch 49.


Note: If you would like foundation ch to match colors used in Row 1, work as follows: With A, ch 8; with D, ch 8; with A, ch 8; with B, ch 9. When changing yarn color, leave long yarn tails to weave in later.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, changing yarn color following Row 1 of Chart – you will have 48 sc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across, changing yarn color following Row 2 of Chart.

Continue to work in rows of sc, changing yarn color following Chart, until all 64 rows of Chart have been worked 4 times, for a total of 256 rows from beg.

Beginning again with Row 1 of Chart, work until you have completed Row 16 of Chart. Fasten off.



FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Fringe

Cut 2 strands of A about 25.5 in. (65 cm) long. Hold strands together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through one short end of Scarf, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten.

Make 20 fringes evenly spaced along each end of Scarf.

Trim fringe ends evenly.

beg = begin(ning)

ch = chain

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
