

Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® TRUBOO AMIGURUMI BEAR

Pattern Number: M21019 TB



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SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 7 in. (18 cm) tall

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND[®] TRUBOO (Art. #837)
 #123 Tan 1 ball
- LION BRAND[®] stitch markers
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook C-2 (2.75 mm) Small amount of black yarn for embroidery 2 safety eyes, 10mm diameter Fiberfill stuffing

GAUGE

24 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

inv-dec (invisible single crochet decrease) Insert hook in front loop only of each of next 2 sts, yarn over and draw through both sts, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook -1 st decreased.

NOTES

- 1. Bear is worked in 9 pieces: Body/Head, 2 Arms, 2 Legs, 2 Ears, Bow, and Tail.
- 2. All pieces are worked in rnds.
- 3. Facial features are embroidered.
- 4. Pieces are sewn together and stuffed.
- 5. Exact gauge is not essential for this project. We worked tightly with a small hook so that stuffing wouldn't show through.

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BODY/HEAD

Body

Beg at lower end of body, ch 2.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – you'll have 16 sc in this rnd.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 4: * Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 32 sc.

Rnd 5: * Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 40 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: * Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 48 sc.

Rnd 8: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 9: * Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 56 sc.

Rnds 10-26: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 27: * Sc in next 5 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 48 sc.

Rnds 28 and 29: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 30: * Sc in next 4 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 40 sc.

Rnds 31-33: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 34: * Sc in next 3 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 32 sc.

Rnds 35 and 36: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 37: * Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 24 sc. Stuff Body firmly.

Head

Rnd 38: Work 2 sc in each st around – 48 sc.

Rnd 39: * Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 56 sc.

Rnd 40: * Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 64 sc.

Rnds 41-52: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 53: * Sc in next 6 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 56 sc.

Rnd 54: * Sc in next 5 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 48 sc.

Rnd 55: * Sc in next 4 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 40 sc.

Rnd 56: * Sc in next 3 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 32 sc.

Rnd 57: * Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Stuff Head firmly.

Attach safety eyes to Head between Rnds 48 and 49 about 6 sts apart.

Rnd 58: * Sc in next st, inv-dec; rep from * around – 16 sc.

Rnd 59: (Inv-dec) 8 times – 8 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Thread tail onto blunt needle and sew opening at top of Head closed.

With scrap of black yarn, and using photograph as a guide, embroider eyebrows, nose, and mouth on face.

BOW

Ch 16.

Rnd 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across; join with sl st in first sc -15 sc.

Rnds 2 and 3: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for wrapping and sewing.

Fold Bow circle in half with sl st join in center.

Wrap long ending tail around center of Bow 5 times.

Thread tail onto blunt needle and sew a few sts into center of Bow to secure then sew Bow to Bear's neck.

LEGS (make 2)

Beg at lower end (foot) of leg, ch 2.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 16 sc.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around; JOIN with a sl st in first sc – 24 sc.

Continue to move end of rnd marker up.

Rnd 4: Working in back loops only, sc in each st around; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Rnds 5-15: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 16: * Sc in next 4 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 20 sc.

Rnds 17-25: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

ARMS (make 2)

Beg at lower end (paw) of arm, ch 2.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 16 sc.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around; JOIN with a sl st to first sc – 20 sc.

Continue to move end of rnd marker up.

Rnd 4: Working in back loops only, sc in each st around; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Rnds 5-12: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 13: * Sc in next 3 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 16 sc.

Rnds 14-20: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 21: * Sc in next 6 sts; inv-dec; rep from * around – 14 sc.

Rnds 22 and 23: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

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EARS (make 2)

Ch 2.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 10 sc.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around – 15 sc.

Rnd 4: * Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from * around -20 sc.

Rnds 5 and 6: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 7: * Sc in next 2 sts, inv-dec; rep from * around – 15 sc.

Rnd 8: Sc in each st around; join with a sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

TAIL

Ch 2.

Rnd 1 (RS): Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: * Sc in next 2 sts; 2 sc in next st; rep from * around - 16 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in each st around; join with a sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Stuff Arms and Legs and sew to Body. Attach Arms in a vertical position and Legs horizontally, in a seated position.

Secure mid-section of Legs to Body with a few stitches.

Sew Tail to lower back of Body; stuffing before closing.

Sew Ears to Head.

Weave in ends.
