

# Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® PIMA COTTON CATALINA GRANNY SCARF

Pattern Number: M21020 PC



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## **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

## **SIZES**

About 13 x 80 in. (33 x 203 cm)

## **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® PIMA COTTON (Art. #762)
   #159 Mineral Yellow 2 balls (A)
   #140 Rose Taupe 2 balls (B)
   #178 Dragonfly 2 balls (C)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

6 x 6 in. (15 x 15 cm) square of cardboard for tassels

## **GAUGE**

16 dc = about 5 in. (12.5 cm). 1 Granny Square = about 6 1/4 x 6 1/4 in. (16 x 16 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## STITCH EXPLANATIONS

CI (3 double crochet cluster) Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops rem on hook), \*yarn over, insert hook in same st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook; rep from \* once more, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook.

dc3tog (dc 3 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook – 2 sts decreased.

## **NOTES**

- 1. Scarf is made from 8 Granny Squares and 3 Striped Sections, as shown in Layout Diagram.
- 2. Granny Squares are worked in joined rnds. Striped Sections are worked back and forth in rows.
- 3. Granny Squares are sewn together in pairs, then Striped Sections are worked between the pairs to make the Scarf.
- 4. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

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## **GRANNY SQUARE I** (make 3)

With A, ch 6; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): With A, ch 2 (does not count as a st), \* (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in ring (corner made), ch 2; rep from \* 3 more times; join with sl st in top of first Cl – you will have 8 clusters, 4 ch-2 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps in this rnd.

Fasten off.

Rnd 2: From RS, join B with sl st in any ch-2 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 2, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp, \* ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 2; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 8 clusters, 12 dc, 8 ch-2 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (3 dc and 2 ch-2 sps along each of 4 sides between corners).

Fasten off.

Rnd 3: From RS, join C in any ch-2 sp immediately before a corner, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 2, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp, \* ch 2, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 2, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 3 dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 8 clusters, 28 dc, 8 ch-2 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (7 dc and 2 ch-2 sps along each of 4 sides between corners).

Fasten off.

Rnd 4: From RS, join B in any ch-2 sp immediately before a corner, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-2 sp, ch 2, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp, \* ch 2, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 7 dc, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, (Cl, ch 3, Cl) in next corner ch-3 sp; rep from \* 2 more times, ch 2, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 7 dc; join with sl st in top of beg ch-3 – 8 clusters, 44 dc, 8 ch-2 sps, and 4 corner ch-3 sps (11 dc and 2 ch-2 sps along each of 4 sides between corners).

Fasten off.

**Rnd 5:** From RS, join A in any corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, beg in same ch-3 sp, \* 3 sc in corner ch-3 sp, sc in next Cl, 2 sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next 11 dc, 2 sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next Cl; rep from \* 3 more times; join with sl st in first sc - 80 sc (19 sc along each of 4 sides between center sc of 3-sc corners).

Fasten off.

# **GRANNY SQUARE II** (make 3)

Make same as Granny Square I, working 1 rnd each with B, C, A, C, and B.

# **GRANNY SQUARE III** (make 2)

Make same as Granny Square I, working 1 rnd each with C, A, B, A, and C.

# **Assemble Granny Squares**

- Pair 1: Sew together one Granny Square I and one Granny Square II.
- Pair 2: Sew together one Granny Square III and one Granny Square I.
- Pair 3: Sew together one Granny Square II and one Granny Square III.
- Pair 4: Sew together one Granny Square I and one Granny Square II.

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## STRIPED SECTION I

**Row 1 (RS):** From RS, join A with sl st in center sc of 3-sc corner of Pair 1, so that you are ready to work along a long edge, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), sk same st as joining, sk next st, dc in next st, (ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st) 8 times, ch 1, sk next st, dc in seam between Squares, ch 1, sk next st (the 3rd st of 3-sc corner of next Square), (ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st) 9 times and change to B in last st – 21 dc and 20 ch-1 sps.

**Row 2:** With B, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Cl in first ch-1 sp, \* ch 1, Cl in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch-sp, ch 1, Cl in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 and change to C – 20 Cl, 19 ch-1 sps, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

**Row 3:** With C, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, Cl in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Cl in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to last Cl, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch-3 and change to A - 19 Cl, 20 ch-1 sps, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

**Row 4:** With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in each ch-1 sp and Cl across to beg ch-sp, dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 and change to C - 41 dc.

**Row 5:** With C, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, sk next st, dc in next st, \*ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st; rep from \* across working last st in top of beg ch-3 and change to A - 21 dc and 20 ch-1 sps.

Row 6: With A, work same as Row 4 and change to B in last st.

**Row 7:** With B, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk next st, 3 dc in next st, \* sk next 2 sts, 3 dc in next st; rep from \* to last 2 sts, sk next st, dc in last st – Thirteen 3-dc groups and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

**Row 8:** With B, ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc3tog, \* ch 2, dc3tog; rep from \* to last st, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch and change to A - 13 dc3tog, 12 ch-2 sps, 2 ch-1 sps, and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

**Row 9:** With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, \* dc in next st, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* to last dc3tog, dc in next dc3tog, dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 and change to C – 41 dc.

Row 10: With C, rep Row 5 and change to A in last st.

Row 11: With A, rep Row 6 and change to B in last st.

Rows 12-21: Rep Rows 2-11.

**Rows 22-27:** Rep Rows 2-5.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

With long tail, sew last row of Striped Section I to one long edge of Pair 2.

#### STRIPED SECTION II

Beg along unsewn long edge of Pair 2, work same as Striped Section I.

With long tail, sew last row of Striped Section II to one long edge of Pair 3.

#### STRIPED SECTION III

Beg along unsewn long edge of Pair 3, work same as Striped Section I.

With long tail, sew last row of Striped Section III to one long edge of Pair 4.

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## FINISHING

## Tassels (make 4)

Cut one 12 in. (30.5 cm) length of B and of C for ties and set aside.

Holding 1 strand each of B and C together, wrap yarn around cardboard 30 times. Thread B tie into blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard. Wrap C strand tightly around loops 1 in. (2.5 cm) below top knot. Knot securely; thread ends onto needle and weave into center of Tassel. Trim Tassel ends evenly. Tie a Tassel to each corner of Scarf.

Weave in ends.
