

# Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® SCARFIE CELIE POCKET SCARF

Pattern Number: M20449 SC



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## SKILL LEVEL – EASY

#### SIZE

About 10 x 75 in. (25.5 x 190.5 cm)

### MATERIALS

- LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> SCARFIE (Art. #826)
   #237 Seafoam/Clay 2 balls
- LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> large-eyed blunt needle

### GAUGE

13 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern of Rows 5-10. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## STITCH EXPLANATIONS

hdc-3rd (half double crochet in 3rd loop) Yarn over, insert hook in 3rd loop of indicated st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

**Note:** When working back and forth in rows, the 3rd loop is on the side of the piece that is facing you, immediately below the front loop.

V-st (V-stitch) Work (dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st.

#### NOTES

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
- 2. Ends of Scarf are folded then seamed to make pockets.

## SCARF

Ch 35.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc) and in each ch across – you will have 33 dc in this row.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch-3.

Row 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc-3rd in each st to beg ch-2, hdc in top of beg ch-2.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-2.

**Row 5:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first 2 sts, V-st in next st, \*sk next st, dc in next st, sk next st, V-st in next st; rep from \* to last 2 sts, sk next st, dc in top of beg ch-3 – 8 V-sts, 7 dc between V-sts and 1 dc at beg and end of row.

**Row 6:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, dc in first st, dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*V-st in next dc between V-sts, dc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* across, 2 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 7 V-sts.

**Row 7:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each dc and ch-1 sp across working last dc in top of beg ch-3 – 33 dc.



**Rows 8-10:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-3. Rep Rows 5-10 until piece measures about 82 in. (208.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 10 as the last row you work.

Next 3 Rows: Rep Rows 5-7.

Next Row: Rep Row 2.

Next Row: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc-3rd in each st to beg ch-2, hdc in top of beg ch-2.

**Next Row:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch-2. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

#### FINISHING

Fold each end of Scarf back about 8 1/2 (21.5 cm).

Take care that the ridges of Row 3 and in 2nd to last row are near top of pockets.

Sew side edges together to make pockets.

Weave in yarn ends.

#### Fringe

Cut 2 strands of yarn each about 15 in. (38 cm) long. Hold strands together and fold in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through lower edge of one pocket, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten.

Make fringe evenly spaced along lower edge of each pocket.

Trim ends of fringe evenly.
