**ANNA ADULT COWL**

## SKILL LEVEL – EASY

## SIZES

**Finished Circumference** About 31 in. (79 cm)

**Finished Height** About 13 in. (33 cm)

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® SPEKTACULAR (Art. #955)
  - #300 Snow 1 ball (A)
  - #310 Hot Pink 1 ball (B)
  - #302 Aqua 1 ball (C)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 13 (9 mm), 24 in. (61 cm) long

Circular knitting needle size 15 (9 mm), 24 in. (61 cm) long

## GAUGE

7 sts = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm); 9 rnds = about 4 1/4 in. (11 cm) in Stockinette st worked in rnds (k every rnd), blocked.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## NOTES

1. Cowl is worked in rnds in one piece.
2. When changing yarn color, do not cut old color. Carry color not in use along WS of piece. If carrying color across 5 or more sts, twist yarns on WS to prevent overly long strands (floats) on the WS.
3. Colorwork can be worked by following written instructions or the Chart. Read all rnds of Chart from right to left.

## COWL

With smaller needle and A, cast on 48 sts.

Place marker for beginning of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

**Next 4 Rnds:** \* K1, p1; rep from \* around.

Change to larger needle.

**Note:** If you choose to follow the chart for the colorwork, you can place markers on Rnd 1 to define the repeats of the chart. For ease in working, use different color markers than the beginning of rnd marker.

If you choose to work from the written instructions, you needn't place the markers.

**Rnd 1:** With A, k12, \* place marker (pm), k12; rep from \* 2 more times.

Slip markers as you come to them.

**Rnd 2:** \* With B, k1; with A, k2; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 3:** \* With A, k1; with B, k1; with A, k3; with B, k3; with A, k3; with B, k1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 4:** \* With B, k1; with A, k3; with B, k5; with A, k3; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 5:** With A, k3; with B, k7; \* with A, k5; with B, k7; rep from \* to last 2 sts; with A, k2.

**Rnds 6 and 7:** With A, k2; with B, k9; \* with A, k3; with B, k9; rep from \* to last st; with A, k1.

**Rnd 8:** With A, k2; with B, k4; with A, k1; with B, k4; \* with A, k3; with B, k4; with A, k1; with B, k4; rep from \* to last st; with A, k1.

**Rnd 9:** (With A, k3; with B, k2) twice; \* with A, k5; with B, k2; with A, k3; with B, k2; rep from \* to last 2 sts; with A, k2.

**Rnd 10:** With A, knit.

**Rnd 11:** \* With C, k1; with A, k5; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 12:** With C, k2; with A, k3; \* with C, k3; with A, k3; rep from \* to last st; with C, k1.

**Rnd 13:** With C, k3; with A, k1; \* with C, k5; with A, k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts; with C, k2.

**Rnd 14:** Rep Rnd 12.

**Rnd 15:** Rep Rnd 11.

**Rnd 16:** With A, knit.

**Rnd 17:** \* With A, k1; with C, k1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 18:** \* With C, k1; with A, k1; rep from \* around.

**Rnd 19:** With C, knit.

Cut A and B.

Change to smaller needle.

Next 4 Rnds: With A, \* k1, p1; rep from \* around.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Block.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**k** = knit  
**p** = purl  
**rep** = repeat  
**rnd(s)** = round(s)  
**st(s)** = stitch(es)  
**WS** = wrong side
