



Free Crochet Pattern

LION BRAND® RESPUN THICK & QUICK®

TESSIE CROCHET RIPPLE THROW

Pattern Number: M21031 RNTQ



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 35 x 45 in. (89 x 114.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® RESPUN THICK & QUICK® (Art. #843)
 - #151 Pumice Stone 1 ball (A)
 - #126 Espresso 1 ball (B)
 - #114 Dark Cherry 1 ball (C)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size N-13 (9 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

1 ripple = about 7 in. (18 cm) measured from peak to peak.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. Throw is worked in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. The ripple pattern in the design is created by skipping 2 sts to form valleys and working (dc, ch 2, dc) to form peaks. In each row, take care that the valleys are centered over valleys and the (dc, ch 2, dc) are worked in the ch-2 sp of peaks of previous row.
3. Yarn color is changed following Stripe Sequence. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 4 rows with A, 4 rows with B, 4 rows with C, 7 rows with A, 7 rows with B, 7 rows with C, 4 rows with A, 4 rows with B, and 4 rows with C for a total of 45 rows.

THROW

With A, ch 77.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch do not count as a st), dc in next 5 ch, * (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, dc in next 6 ch, sk next 2 ch, dc in next 6 ch; rep from * across to last 8 ch, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch, dc in next 5 ch, dc2tog – you will have 5 ripples in this row.

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Rows 2-4: Ch 3 (does not count as a st), turn, working in back loops only, sk first st, dc in next 6 sts, * (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch-2 sp, dc in next 6 sts, sk next 2 sts, dc in next 6 sts; rep from * to last ch-2 sp, (dc, ch 2, dc) in last ch-2 sp, dc in next 5 sts, dc2tog; leave beginning ch unworked. Change to B in last st of Row 4.

Rep Row 2 and continue to change yarn color following Stripe Sequence until all 45 rows of sequence have been completed.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ch = chain

ch-sp = chain space previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)
