

Free Knitting Pattern LION BRAND® RESPUN THICK & QUICK® SEDONA SAMPLER THROW

Pattern Number: M21053 RNTQ



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SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 40 x 52 in. (101.5 x 132 cm)

MATERIALS

LION BRAND[®] RESPUN THICK & QUICK[®] (Art. #843) #126 Espresso 1 ball (A) #149 Silver 1 ball (B) #133 Cinnamon Stick 1 ball (C) #172 Olive Branch 1 ball (D) #102 Desert Sand 1 ball (E) #173 Spruce 1 ball (F) #114 Dark Cherry 1 ball (G) #098 Whipped Cream 1 ball (H) #110 Night Sky 1 ball (I) #144 Wisteria 1 ball (J)



- LION BRAND® circular knitting needle size 10.5 (6.5 mm), 29 in. (73.5 cm) long
- LION BRAND[®] stitch markers
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle

GAUGE

14 sts = about 5 in. (12.5 cm); 15 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them tog – 1 st decreased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

PATTERN STITCHES

Seed St (worked over an even number of sts)

Row 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end.

Row 2: P the knit sts, and k the purl sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

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Eyelet Pattern (worked over a multiple of 4 sts)

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 3: * K2tog, yo, k2; rep from * to end.

Row 5: Knit.

Row 7: K2, * k2tog, yo, k2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 8: Purl.

Rep Rows 1-8 for Eyelet pattern.

Diamond Lace Pattern (worked over a multiple of 8 sts)

Row 1 (RS): * K1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, ssk, k2; rep from * to end.
Row 2 and all WS rows: Purl.
Row 3: * K2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, k1; rep from * to end.
Row 5: * Yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1; rep from * to end.
Row 7: * K1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2; rep from * to end.
Row 8: Purl.
Rep Rows 1-8 for Diamond Lace pattern.

NOTES

- 1. Throw is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows.
- 2. The Throw is made with 9 different pattern sts and 11 sections. Each section is worked with a different yarn color.
- 3. When working the different sts and sections, the st count will not change.
- 4. A circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.
- 5. When you see 'work in pattern as established' in the instructions, this means to work the next row of the current pattern, lining up sts as in previous rows.

THROW

Section 1: Ribbing

With A, cast on 112 sts.

Rows 1-8: * K2, p2; rep from * to end of row.

Cut A.

Section 2: Garter st

With B, work in Garter st (k every st on every row) for 20 rows.

Cut B.

Section 3: St st

Row 1 (RS): With C, knit.

Row 2: K4, place marker (pm), p to last 4 sts, pm, k4.

Row 3: K4, slip marker (sm), k to next marker, sm, k4.

Rows 4-20: Keeping first and last 4 sts in Garter st, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) between markers for 17 more rows, slipping markers as you come to them.

Cut C and remove markers.

Section 4: Seed st

Row 1 (RS): With D, work Row 1 of Seed st across row. Rows 2-20: Work Row 2 of Seed st for 19 more rows. Cut D.

Section 5: Eyelet Pattern

Row 1 (RS): With E, k4, pm, work Row 1 of Eyelet pattern to last 4 sts, pm, k4.

Rows 2-24: Keeping first and last 4 sts in Garter st, work in Eyelet pattern between markers as established for 23 more rows, slipping markers as you come to them.

Cut E. Do not remove markers.

Section 6: Reverse St st stripes

Row 1 (RS): With F, k4, sm, p to next marker, sm, k4.
Row 2: With F, knit, slipping markers as you come to them.
Drop F to the WS but do not cut.
Rows 3 and 4: With B, rep Rows 1 and 2.
Drop B to the WS but do not cut.
Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 1-4 three more times, changing yarn color every other row, for a total of 16 rows.
Cut B and F and remove markers.

Section 7: Basketweave

Row 1 (RS): With G, * k4, p4; rep from * to end of row.
Row 2: * P4, k4; rep from * to end of row.
Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2.
Row 5: * P4, k4; rep from * to end of row.
Row 6: * K4, p4; rep from * to end of row.
Rows 7 and 8: Rep Rows 5 and 6.
Rows 9-16: Rep Rows 1-8 once more.
Cut G.

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Section 8: Diamond Lace

Row 1: With H, k4, pm, work Row 1 of Diamond Lace pattern to last 4 sts, pm, k4.

Rows 2-24: Keeping first and last 4 sts in Garter st, work in Diamond Lace pattern as established between markers for 23 more rows, slipping markers as you come to them.

Cut H. Do not remove markers.

Section 9: Texture st

Row 1 (RS): With I, knit, slipping markers as you come to them.
Row 2: K4, sm, p to next marker, sm, k4.
Row 3: K4, sm, * k1, p1; rep from * to next marker, sm, k4.
Row 4: Rep Row 2.
Rows 5-20: Rep Rows 1-4 four more times for a total of 20 rows.
Cut I and remove markers.

Section 10: Garter st Stripes

Rows 1 and 2: With J, work in Garter st (k every st on every row) for 2 rows.

Drop J to the WS but do not cut.

Rows 3 and 4: With B, work in Garter st for 2 rows.

Drop B to the WS but do not cut.

Rows 5-20: Rep Rows 1-4 four more times, changing yarn color every other row, for a total of 20 rows. Cut J and B.

Section 11: Ribbing

Rows 1-8: With A, * k2, p2; rep from * to end of row. Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
p = purl
rep = repeat
RS = right side
st(s) = stitch(es)
St st = Stockinette stitch
WS = wrong side
