CAL SHAWL RECIPE

SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

Our sample was about 45 x 97 in. (114.5 x 246.5 cm) at widest and longest

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-PILLING™ (Art. #202)

#99 Ivory 1 ball (A)

#121 Almond 1 ball (B)

#184 Peachy 1 ball (C)

#122 Hazelnut 1 ball (D)

#123 Cedarwood 1 ball (E)

#125 Truffle 1 ball (F)

#126 Mahogany 1 ball (G)

#135 Adobe 1 ball (H)

#129 Cocoa 1 ball (I)

#128 Ebony 1 ball (J)

- LION BRAND® crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

Exact gauge is not required for this project.

Shi Says...

My recipe lists the hook size used for the sample Shawl – but experiment with different size hooks to find one that’s comfortable for you to use and that creates a ‘fabric’ that you love!

NOTES

1. Shawl is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows, beginning at center back neck.
2. The sample Shawl was worked with 10 colors of yarn and is shaped with increases.
3. The yarn color on the sample Shawl was changed as desired. We started with yarn color A, then worked through B, C, etc. but didn’t work a specific number of rows before changing to the next color.
4. We used about a third of the ball of yarn color A, but then used more and more of subsequent balls. We used nearly all of the last color.
5. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.

Shi Says...

Make your Shawl your way! Use your favorite colors and change yarn colors whenever you like.

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SHAWL

With A, ch 4.

Row 1: With A, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc) – you will have 6 dc and 1 ch-2 sp in Row 1.

Row 2: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc, 2 ch-1 sps, and 1 ch-2 sp (6 dc and 1 ch-1 sp on each side of center ch-2 sp).

Row 3: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in center ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 18 dc, 4 ch-1 sps, and 1 ch-2 sp (9 dc and 2 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp).

Row 4: With A, ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, 2 dc in first st,, *ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * to center ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in center ch-2 sp, **ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from ** to last 3 sts, 3 dc in top of beg ch-3 – 12 dc (Four 3-dc groups) and 3 ch-1 sps on each side of center ch-2 sp.

Rep Row 4, changing yarn color as desired, until you're happy with the size of your Shawl.

NOTE

You will have 1 more 3-dc group and 1 more ch-1 sp on each side of the center ch-2 sp in each row.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

ch = chain

ch-sp(s) = chain space(s) previously made

dc = double crochet

rep = repeat

st(s) = stitch(es)

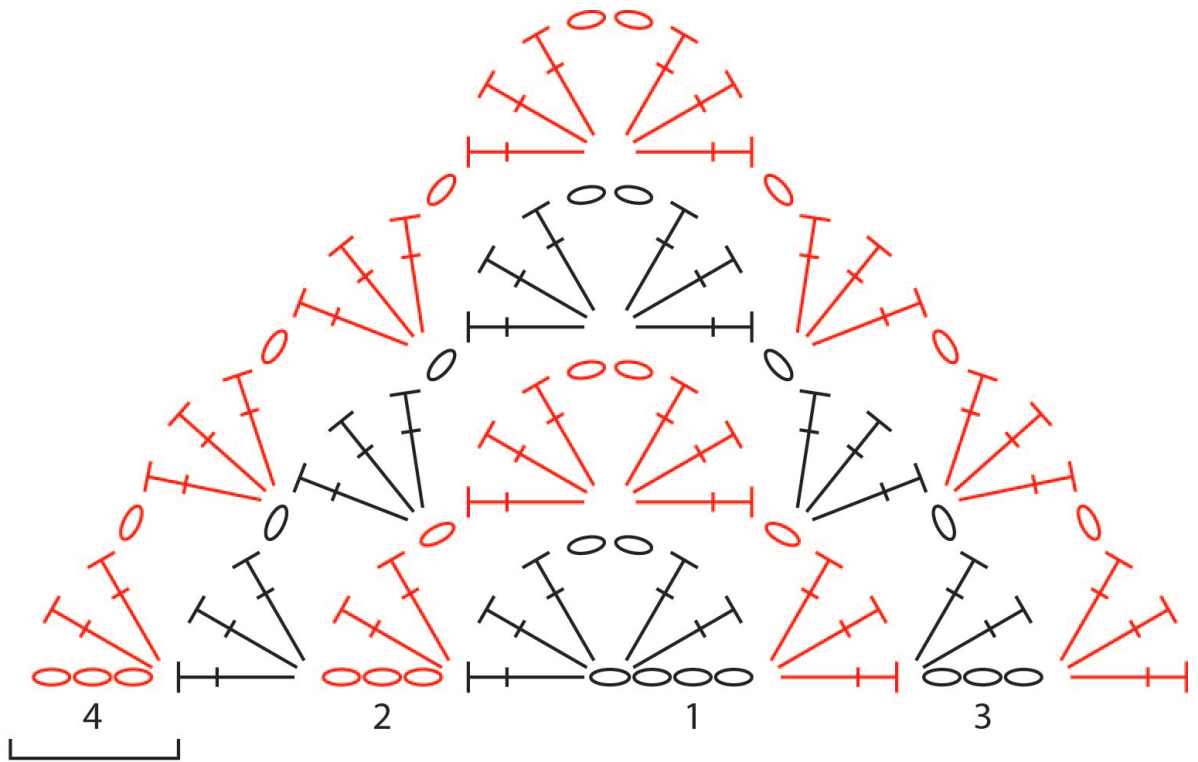
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Repeat Row 4

There will be 1 more 3-dc group
 and 1 more ch-1 sp on each side
 of the center ch-2 sp in each row.
