## VINTAGE

## GRAPE VARIETY

100% Pinot Noir

## VINEYARDS

Made from grapes grown in Kent (96%) and East Sussex (4%), primarily on chalk soils.

## WINEMAKING

The majority of our Pinot Noir fruit is reserved for our sparkling wines, however the exceptional 2020 vintage gave near perfect conditions from which to produce a stunning single varietal rosé expression. Grapes were hand-picked and whole-bunch pressed before cool fermentation in stainless steel to preserve the natural fruit flavours.

## ANALYSIS

Residual Sugar: 1.6 g/l

ABV: 11.5%

pH: 3.17

TA: 7.6 g/l

## TASTING NOTES

Chapel Down Pinot Noir Rosé is delicate with aromas of cranberry, citrus, and raspberry. The texture is light and almost weightless on the palate with a long, fresh finish.

## SERVING SUGGESTION

The light and delicate character of the wine will make it a natural partner with shellfish.
