Keep a fire extinguisher near this product at all times.

Some parts of this braai have been pre-oiled at the factory. Please burn off the oils before cooking.

Do not wear loose clothing when using braai or allow hair to come in contact with braai.

Never use braai on a wooden surface or other flammable surfaces. Use braai only on a hard, stable surface that can support the braai's weight.

Keep 3 meters of clearance between braai and any combustible materials when braai is in use (including, but not limited to bushes, shrubs, trees, leaves, grass, wooden decks or fences, buildings, etc.).

Keep braai away from gasoline and/or other flammable liquids, flammable gases, flammable vapors, or areas where these may be present. Do not store or use braai in these areas.

In windy conditions, place in an outdoor area that is sheltered from wind.

Keep out of reach of children and pets, store out of reach of children when not in use.

When moving or lifting braai, use caution to avoid back strains or injuries.

Do not try to move or reposition braai while it is in use..

Do not use gasoline, kerosene, or alcohol to light charcoal. Using any of these products (or similar products) could cause a flare up, flash fire, or explosion. Severe bodily injury could be result.

Do not add lighter fluid to warm or hot coals. A flash fire may result that could cause bodily injury.

Do not add instant light charcoal briquettes to an existing fire. A flash fire may result that could cause bodily injury.


Do not leave hot braai or hot coals and ashes unattended.








Step 1:


Insert Leg Type 2 through the slot in Leg Type 1 and fasten with x1 nut and x1 bolt. Do this step two times to create both leg assemblies





Step 2:


Slot the leg assembly onto the Main Body. Repeat this step on the opposite side of the braai to position the other leg assembly.






Step 3:

Slot the Body Side onto the partially assembled Main Body and leg assembly and fasten with x5 nuts and x5 bolts. Repeat this step on the opposite side of the braai.








Step 4:

Loosen only x1 nut where the leg assembly intersects and place the Red accent filler in the opening from the inside of the unit. Replace the x1 nut and fasten. Repeat this step on the opposite side of the braai to attach the other Red accent filler.










Step 5:

Attach the side shelf with the lower bracket supporting the side shelf from the bottom. Use x2 nuts to fasten the bracket.

The bottle opener needs to be attached to the opposite side on the side shelf.






Step 6:

When you are done assembling the body of your braai, place the two piece grids on top of your braai. Place the smaller grid on the lower slot and then the bigger grid on top for the grids to slide over each other.

Your braai is then ready to start braaiing on.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS





DANGER!

CARBON MONOXIDE HAZARD.

Burning charcoal inside can kill you. It gives off carbon monoxide, which has no odor. NEVER burn charcoal inside homes, vehicles or tents.

WARNING

Most surfaces on this unit are hot when in use. Use extreme caution. Keep others away from unit. Always wear protective clothing to prevent injury.

Keep away from children and pets.

Do not move this unit during operation.

Never substitute gasoline, kerosene or alcohol for charcoal starter. In this case, paraffin-based starter cubes can be substituted for charcoal starter. Never use charcoal starter fluid with an electric starter.

USING CHARCOAL

Your charcoal braai is made to burn either charcoal briquettes or natural wood lump charcoal — both of which have different cooking attributes. Briquettes typically provide longer burn times that lump charcoal — but lump charcoal burns hotter than briquettes.

LIGHTING THE FIRE

Remove the grid from the Charcoal Braai.

Add charcoal. Do not put more than 4 Kg of charcoal briquettes or lump charcoal into the pan. – use charcoal lighters to start the fire, following directions supplied by the manufacturer of the fire lighters.

Allow the charcoal enough time to completely ash over before beginning to cook, so that the lighter fluid has enough time to burn off. Starting to cook too soon can leave your food tasting like lighter fluid. After ash-over is complete, use long-handled tongs to spread the charcoal into a single layer on the pan.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

BRAAI MAINTENANCE

Frequency of cleaning is determined by how often the braai is used. Make sure coals are completely extinguished and the grid is cooled down before cleaning inside of the unit. Use of a cleaning pad is recommended. Wipe out the interior of unit with cloth or paper towel after the coals are removed. Store in cool dry place.

WARRANTY



The manufacturer warrants to the original consumer-purchaser <u>only</u> that this product (*Model 700 Crossover 2.0*) shall be free from defects in workmanship and materials after correct assembly and under normal and reasonable home use for the periods indicated below beginning on the date of purchase.
