

# Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® COVER STORY SARABETH SHAWL

Pattern Number: M21044 CV



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# **SKILL LEVEL –** EASY

### SIZES

Finished Wingspan About 75 in. (190.5 cm) measured along top edge.

**Finished Length** About 36 in. (01.5 cm) measured from center top edge down to center point, not including fringe

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> COVER STORY (Art. #533)
   #232 Domino 1 cake
- LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> crochet hook size N (10 mm)
- LION BRAND<sup>®</sup> large-eyed blunt needle

### GAUGE

8 dc = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

#### NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked back and forth in rows in one piece, from lower center point upwards.
- 2. Increases are worked at beg and end of every row to shape the Shawl

#### SHAWL

Ch 8.

**Row 1:** Dc in 6th ch from hook (5 skipped ch count as 1 base ch, dc, ch 1), ch 1, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have 3 dc and 2 ch-1 sps in this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc in first st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 4th ch of beg ch-5 - 5 dc and 4 ch-1 sps.

**Row 3:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc in first st, \* ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc; rep from \* to beg ch-sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 7 dc and 6 ch-1 sps.

**Row 4:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc in first st, dc in each ch-1 sp and dc across to beg ch-sp, dc in beg ch-sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 15 dc and 2 ch-1 sps.

**Row 5:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, dc in first st, ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, \* ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from \* to beg ch-sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of beg ch-4 – 11 dc and 10 ch-1 sps.

Rows 6-32: Rep Rows 3-5 for 9 more times – 65 dc and 64 ch-1 sps in Row 32.

**Row 33:** Rep Row 3 – 67 dc and 66 ch-1 sps.

Fasten off.



#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.

#### Fringe

Cut strands of yarn about 12 in. (30.5 cm) long. For each fringe, fold 1 strand in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of shawl, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten.

Make fringe in end of each row along shaped sides of Shawl, with 1 strand of yarn in each fringe. Trim fringe evenly.
