

# Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® FEELS LIKE BUTTA-GO FOR FAUX LITTLE BO SHEEP AMIGURUMI

Pattern Number: M21069 FB GF



## **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

## **SIZES**

Finished Width About 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm) Finished Height About 6 in. (15 cm)

## **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® FEELS LIKE BUTTA (Art. #215)
   #150 Charcoal 1 ball (A)
- LION BRAND® GO FOR FAUX (Art. #322)
   #302 Star 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

2 safety eyes, 10 mm diameter Fiberfill stuffing

## **GAUGE**

24 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm) with smaller hook and A. EXACT GAUGE IS NOT ESSENTIAL FOR THIS PROJECT.

## STITCH EXPLANATION

**sc2tog (sc 2 sts together)** (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

## NOTES

- 1. Sheep is made in 8 pieces: Head, 2 Ears, Body, and 4 Legs.
- 2. Pieces are stuffed then sewn together.
- 3. Exact gauge is not essential for this project. We worked tightly with a small hook so that stuffing does not show through spaces between stitches

#### HEAD

With smaller hook and A, ch 13.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 10 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working along opposite side of foundation ch, sc in next 10 ch, 3 sc in next ch; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – you will have 27 sc in this rnd.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Sc in next 11 sts, 2 sc in next 3 sts, sc in next 10 sts, 2 sc in next 3 sts – 33 sc.

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Rnds 3-10: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 11: Sc2tog, sc in next 11 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 10 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts – 29 sc.

Rnds 12-18: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off A.

Attach safety eyes between Rnds 14 and 15, about 3 sts apart.

# Top of Head

**Rnd 19:** With larger hook, join B with sc in first st, sc in next st, \* sk next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc -20 sc.

Rnd 20: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Stuff Head.

Thread yarn tail through top of sts of last rnd. Pull tail to close opening and knot.

## **BODY**

With larger hook and B, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) – 10 sc.

Place a marker in last st made for end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 20 sc.

Rnd 3: \* Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

Rnds 4-11: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 12: \* Sc in next 2 sts, sk next st; rep from \* around – 20 sc.

Rnd 13: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 14: \* Sc in next st, sk next st; rep from \* around – 10 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Stuff Body.

Thread yarn tail through top of sts of last rnd. Pull tail to close opening and knot.

# EARS (make 2)

With smaller hook and A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 8 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 4: \* Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

Rnd 5: \* Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 16 sc.

Rnds 6 and 7: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 8: \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

Rnds 9 and 10: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## LEGS (make 4)

With smaller hook and A, ch 2.

- **Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc 6 sc.
- **Rnd 2:** Ch 1, 2 sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc 12 sc.
- Rnd 3: Ch 1, \* sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc 18 sc.
- **Rnd 4:** Ch 1, working in the back loops only, \* sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral) 24 sc.

Place a marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

- Rnd 5: Sc in each st around.
- Rnd 6: \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around 18 sc.
- Rnd 7: \* Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from \* around 12 sc.
- Rnds 8 and 9: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

#### **FINISHING**

Sew Head to Body and Ears to Head.

Stuff Legs and sew to Body.

Weave in ends.
