TRICK OR TREAT PILLOW

SKILL LEVEL – INTERMEDIATE

APPROXIMATE CRAFTING TIME: VARIES

SIZES

About 20 x 12 in. (51 x 30.5 cm)

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-PILING™ (Art. #202)
#303 Volt Yellow 3 balls (A)
#302 Iron Grey 1 ball (B)
#300 Summit White 2 balls (C)
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size G-6 (4.25 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle
- 20 x 12 in. (51 x 30.5 cm) pillow form



GAUGE

14 sc + 17 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

DIRECTIONS

1. Pillow cover is worked in 2 pieces: Front and Back.
2. Front is worked back and forth in rows, changing yarn color following a Chart. Each box on Chart represents one single crochet (sc) worked with the indicated yarn. Read RS rows of Chart from right to left and WS rows from left to right.
3. To change yarn color, work the last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. When working Front, do not cut old color. Carry yarn color not in use along tops of sts of previous row and work current sts over the top of the carried strand. When working Back, fasten off old color.
4. Back is worked back and forth in rows changing yarn color following Stripe Sequence.

FRONT

With A, ch 69.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 68 sc in this row.

Rows 2-12: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 13: Ch 1, turn sc in each st across changing yarn color following Row 13 of Chart.

Rows 10-52: Continue to work in rows of sc changing yarn color following Chart until all 52 rows of Chart have been completed.

Fasten off.

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BACK

Stripe Sequence: Work 8 rows with A, (14 rows with C, 8 rows with A) twice for a total of 52 rows in Stripe Sequence.

With A, ch 69.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 68 sc in this row.

Rows 2-52: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across AND continue to change yarn color following Stripe Sequence.

Do not fasten off.

FINISHING

Hold Front and Back with RS together and sts and ends of rows matching.

Working from WS and through both thicknesses, with yarn still attached to Back, sc along 3 sides of pillow cover. Leave remaining side open. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Turn piece RS out.

Insert pillow form then sew last side closed.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sc = single crochet

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side

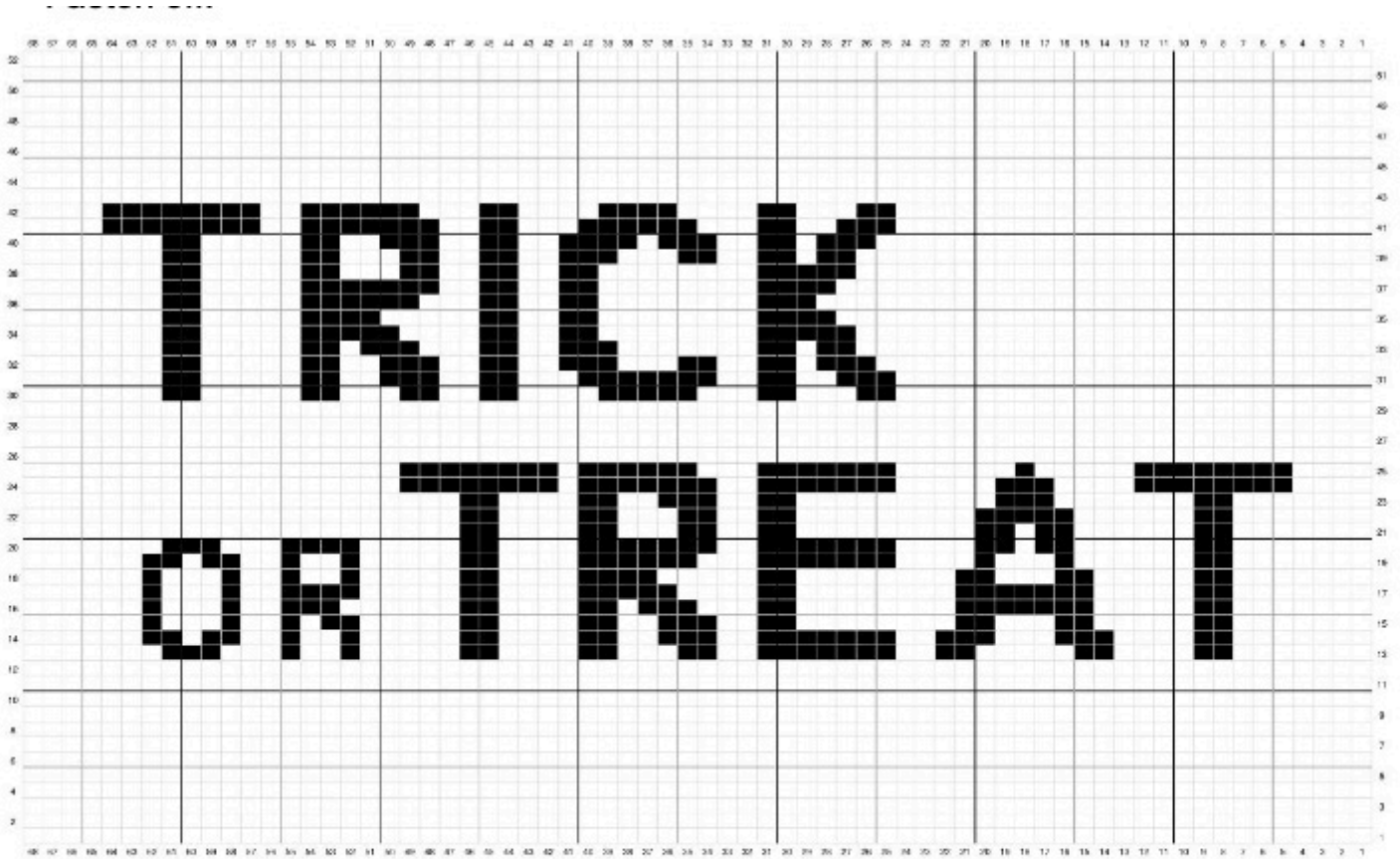
