ABOUT OUR CARIGNAN

Our Tower 15, 2019 Carignan has a balanced flavor profile without bitter tannin, and tends to pack a big flavorful punch on the opening palate. The grapes for this limited-quantity bottling derive from Camp 4 Vineyard, owned by the Chumash Tribe, in the Los Olivos District of the Santa Ynez Valley where they grow Rhône and select Bordeaux varietals. This wine was barrel-fermented and barrel-aged using only neutral French oak barrels. The majority of our Carignan was added to our 'Jetty' blend, leaving only a limited amount for this single varietal bottling.
