Scholarship Program

The Maine Difference Scholarship, a program funded by **Lamey-Wellehan**, is intended to aid in the cost of attaining an education for a Maine young person studying at a Maine college or university. The focus of the student's studies should be on the ecology and economics of Maine. The emphasis on these aspects with Maine as an intense background is structured to ensure that both the student and the State of Maine benefit from the scholarship and careers that result from the student's education. The award is a renewable \$1,000 scholarship for full-time undergraduate study at any college or university in Maine. To be eligible to receive The Maine Difference Scholarship, the applicant must be either:

1. a high school senior who will graduate in the spring and who will enter college in the fall; or
2. a graduate of high school in one of the four years preceding the current year who will be enrolled in college in the fall.

To apply, complete this application packet and return it with a recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor and a transcript of your grades. The deadline for applications is no later than May 30.
