The Mondeluz pencil lead is soft and vibrant, consisting of water-soluble pigments. The effect is dense color that lays down easily. Water may be added by brushing over the hand drawn strokes to soften and blur the lines, creating a watercolor paint effect, or the pencil may be dipped in water prior to drawing to create a deep, rich stroke. These pencils can be used on a multitude of wet and dry surfaces, such as vellum, canvas, and watercolor paper. Mondeluz aquarells can also be used with other media such as traditional watercolor, graphite, pastel, ink and acrylic paint.
