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MATERIALS

- 2 skeins Lion Brand Hue + Me in Salt (617-098) for color A
- 1 (2, 2) skein(s) Lion Brand Hue + Me in Fatigues (617-174) for color B
- 1 (2, 2) skein(s) Lion Brand Hue + Me in Grapefruit (617-104) for color C
- 1 (1, 2) skein(s) Lion Brand Hue + Me in Peacoat (617-110) for color D
- 1 (1, 2) skein(s) Lion Brand Hue + Me in Toast (617-124) for color E (bulky, weight 5; 137yds/125m per skein)
- Size US N/P/15 (10mm) crochet hook
- Removable stitch marker
- Tapestry needle

GAUGE

8 sts + 6.5 rows = 4"/10 cm in half double crochet

ABBREVIATIONS

All Two of Wands patterns are written in standard US terms.

Ch Chain

Hdc Half double crochet

Rep Repeat

RS Right side

Sc Single crochet


SI st Slip stitch

NOTES

Poncho is worked flat from the top down in back and forth rows. Turn at the end of each row. To change color, work the final yarn over of the previous stitch with the new color. Poncho is reversible – the collar can be worn with the ribbing facing out or facing in to show when folded over. Pattern is written for three sizes: XS/S/M (L/XL/2XL, 3XL/4XL).

COLLAR

With color A, ch 10.

Row 1 (RS) Starting in 2nd ch from hook and working in back bump of foundation ch, sc across row. (9 sts)

Row 2 (WS) SI st loosely across row.

Row 3 Ch 1, sc across row.

Rep rows 2 and 3 until work measures 26 (28, 30)"/66 (71, 76)cm, ending with a RS row. Fasten off.

Fold ribbing in half so that first and last row meet, and mark the center so that there are 13 (14, 15)"/33 (35.5, 38)cm on either side.

BODY

Rectangle 1: Color B

With RS facing, join color B to being working down long edge of collar.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 26 (28, 30) evenly along long edge of collar to halfway point marker. (26 (28, 30) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color C on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 2: Color C

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 1.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 1, then hdc 26 (28, 30) evenly along long edge of collar from halfway point marker to end, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 1 to connect the neckline. (38 (40, 42) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color D on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 3: Color D

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 2.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 2, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 1, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 2. (38 (40, 42) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color E on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 4: Color E

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 3.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 3, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 2, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 3. (50 (52, 54) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color A on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 5: Color A

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 4.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 4, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 3, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 4. (50 (52, 54) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color B on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 6: Color B

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 5.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 5, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 4, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 5. (62 (64, 66) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color C on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 7: Color C

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 6.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 6, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 5, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 6. (62 (64, 66) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color D on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 8: Color D

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 7.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 7, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 6, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 7. (74 (76, 78) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color E on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 9: Color E

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 8.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 8, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 7, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 8. (74 (76, 78) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color A on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 10: Color A

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 9.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 9, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 8, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 9. (86 (88, 90) sts)

Rows 2-5 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Sizes L/XL/2XL (3XL/4XL) only:

Change to color B on final yarn over of last st of previous rectangle.

Rectangle 11: Color B

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 10.

- Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 10, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 9, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 10. (88 (90) sts)
- Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.
- Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color C on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 12: Color C

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 11.

- Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 11, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 10, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 11. (100 (102) sts)
- Rows 2-5 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Size 3XL/4XL only:

Change to color D on final yarn over of last st of previous rectangle.

Rectangle 13: Color D

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 12.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 12, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 11, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 12. (102) sts)

Rows 2-4 Ch 1, hdc across row.

Row 5 Ch 1, hdc across row, changing to color E on final yarn over of last st.

Rectangle 14: Color E

Keeping RS facing, rotate work to being working along short edge of rectangle 13.

Row 1 (RS) Ch 1, hdc 6 evenly along short edge of rectangle 13, then hdc in each st along long edge of rectangle 12, then hdc 6 evenly along opposite short edge of rectangle 13. (114) sts)

Rows 2-5 Ch 1, hdc across row.

All sizes:

Fasten off.

Secure and weave in all ends.



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
