

Free Knitting Pattern LION BRAND® 24/7 COTTON®

ORCHARD BEACH BANDANA

Pattern Number: M21260 TC



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

Finished Length About 10 in. (25.5 cm), measured from lower point to top edge **Finished Width** About 13 in. (33 cm), not including ties

MATERIALS

LION BRAND® 24/7 COTTON® (Art. #761)

#157 Lemon 1 ball (A)

#100 White 1 ball (B)

#107 Sky 1 ball (C)

#156 Mint 1 ball (D)

#158 Goldenrod 1 ball (E)

#142 Rose 1 ball (F)

- LION BRAND® knitting needles size 8 (5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

17 sts = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm); 26 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) BE SURE TO CHECK GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

- 1. Bandana is worked back and forth in rows of St st (k on RS, p on WS) with a Garter st (k this st on WS and on RS) at beginning and end of every row.
- 2. Work begins at lower back point.
- 3. Increases (yo) are worked at the beg and end of each row to shape the Bandana.
- 4. Yarn color is changed to form stripes.
- 5. Ties are knit in one with the Bandana.

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BANDANA

With A, cast on 3 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, (yo, k1) twice – you will have 5 sts in this row.

Row 2: K1, p to last st, k last st.

Row 3: K1, yo, k to last st, yo, k last st -7 sts.

Row 4: K1, p to last st, k last st.

Rows 5-60: Rep Rows 3 and 4 and change yarn color as follows: Work next 12 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 4 rows with C, 4 rows with D, 4 rows with E, 4 rows with F, 2 rows with B, and 24 rows with A – you will have 63 sts in Row 59.

Row 61: With A, knit.

Shape Ties

Continue with A only.

Row 62: Cast on 60 sts for first tie, k to end of row – 123 sts.

Row 63: Cast on 60 sts for second tie, k to end of row – 183 sts.

Rows 64 and 65: Knit.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Dsigner recommends wet blocking.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
