



Free Knitting Pattern

LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-PILLING™

TWIGA HEADBAND

Pattern Number: M22007 BSAP



SKILL LEVEL – INTERMEDIATE

SIZES

Finished Circumference About 21 1/2 in. (54.5 cm)

Finished Width About 4 in. (10 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® BASIC STITCH ANTI-PILLING™ (Art. #202)
 - #300 Summit White 1 ball (A)
 - #302 Iron Grey 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 7 (4.5 mm), 16 in. (40 cm) long

GAUGE

1 Square = about 2 3/4 in. x 2 3/4 in. (7 cm x 7 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Spiked-Leaf (worked over 3 sts) Insert right needle into st that is 4 rows below 2nd st on left needle, knit the st drawing loop up to working height and place it onto left needle, knit this new st together with next st on left needle. * Insert right needle in same st 4 rows below, knit the st drawing loop up to working height and place it onto left needle, knit this new st together with next st on left needle; rep from * once more.

NOTES

1. Headband is made from 8 Squares, worked in 4 pairs.
2. For each pair, one Square is knit then sts are picked up along one edge to begin the next Square.
3. Follow the diagram for Square placement and where pairs are sewn together.
4. Squares are worked back and forth in rows, changing yarn color every other row, to form vertical stripes of Spiked-Leaves.
5. Refer to Chart for Square placement and to see where pairs are sewn together.
6. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.
7. Edging is worked onto seamed Headband.

SQUARE #1

With B, cast on 11 sts.

With B, knit 3 rows.

Row 1 (RS): With A, k1, Spiked-Leaf, k3, Spiked-Leaf, k1.

Row 2: With A, k4, p3, k4.

Row 3: With B, k4, Spiked-Leaf, k4.

Row 4: With B, k1, p3, k3, p3, k1.

Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 1-4 for 3 more times, at the end of Row 16 cut A.

Row 17: With B, knit.

With B, bind off as if to knit.

SQUARE #2

From RS with B, pick up and k11 sts evenly spaced along side edge of Square #1 as shown in diagram.

Rep Square #1.

SQUARES #3 AND #4

Rep Squares #1 and #2.

SQUARES #5 AND #6

Rep Squares #1 and #2.

SQUARES #7 AND #8

Rep Squares #1 and #2.

Sew pairs together, following diagram, to make a strip.

Sew ends of strip together to make a ring, matching edge of Square #1 to edge of Square #8.

FINISHING

Edging

From RS with B, pick up and k88 sts evenly spaced around top edge of Headband.

Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle.

Rnd 1: Purl.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnds 3 and 4: Rep Rnds 1 and 2.

Bind off as if to purl.

Rep around lower edge of Headband.

Weave in ends. Block to measurements.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
